Enlistment of Drivers

Basic Qualifications :

- Age should be between 18 and 29 years as at 28.02.2006.
- Height should be not less than 5' 4"
- Should be unmarried Sri Lankan Males.
- Should have studied up to G.C.E. (O/L) Examination.
- Should possess a valid driving licence to drive light vehicles together with one year experience.
- A heavy vehicle driving licence and trade qualification in motor mechanism will be a plus point.

Basic Qualifications for Para Medics

- Age should be between 18 and 28 years as at 28.02.2006.
- Height should be not less than 5' 4"
- Should be unmarried Sri Lankan Males.
- Should have passed 06 subjects at the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination with credit passes in Science and Mathematics or credit passes in Mathematics I and Mathematics II and Science I and Science II.

N.B. - Those who wish to apply for Para Medical Professions should fulfil above basic qualifications in addition to the qualifications stated under the professions.
