Officer Cadet Vacancies

VACANCIES exist in the Sri Lanka Regular Air Force for Officer Cadets in the following branches :

- (a) General Duties Pilot Branch ;
- (b) Operations Air Branch ;
- (c) Administrative Branch ;
- (d) Administrative Regiment Branch.

02. Applications are invited from male candidates who possess the qualifications given below :

- (a) *Nationality* :- Must be a citizen of Sri Lanka ;
- (b) *Age* :- Not less than 18 years and not more than 22 years as at 30.06.2004 ;
- (c) *Educational Qualifications*:-
 - (i) *General Duties Pilot Branch*:- A minimum of ordinary passes in six subjects at the GCE (O/L) examination with four credits including a credit in Mathematics (Mathematics II if an applicant of 1999/2000 years) and an ordinary pass in Science (Science II if an applicant of 1999/2000 years) Sinhala / Tamil and English Languages in one sitting and ordinary passes in three subjects at the GCE (A/L) (New and Old syllabus) examination in Physical/Bio Science subjects in one sitting.
 - (ii) *Operations Air Branch* :- A minimum of ordinary passes in six subjects at the GCE (O/L) examination with four credits including a credit in Mathematics (Mathematics II if an applicant of 1999/2000 years) and English Language and an ordinary pass in Science (Science II if an applicant of 1999/2000 years), Sinhala/ Tamil Languages in one sitting and ordinary passes in three subjects at the GCE A/L (New and Old syllabus) examination in Physical/ Bio Science subjects in one sitting.
 - (iii) *Administrative Branch*:- A minimum of ordinary passes in six subjects at the GCE (O/L) examination with four credits including a credit in Mathematics (Mathematics II if an applicant of 1999/2000 years) and an ordinary pass in Science (Science II if an applicant of 1999/2000 years) Sinhala/Tamil and English Languages in one sitting and ordinary passes in three subjects at the GCE (A/L) (New and Old syllabus) examination in Physical/Bio Science / Commerce subjects in one sitting.
 - (iv) *Administrative Regiment Branch* :- A minimum of ordinary passes in six subjects at the GCE (O/L) examination with four credits including a credit in Mathematics (Mathematics II if an applicant of 1999/2000 years) or Science (Science II if an applicant of 1999/2000 years) and an ordinary pass in either subject and Sinhala/Tamil Languages in one sitting and also an ordinary pass in English Language in two sittings and

passes in three subjects at the GCE A/L (New and Old Syllabus) examination in Physical/Bio Science / Commerce or Art subjects in one sitting ;

- (d) *Height.* - 5'5" (165 cm) and above ;
- (e) *Medical Examination.* - All candidates selected will be medically examined under Sri Lanka Air Force arrangements prior to their enlistments as Cadets ;
- (f) *Civil Status.* - Candidates must be unmarried. No Cadet will be permitted to marry whilst under training and for a further period of one (01) year from the date of Commissioning.

03. Due consideration will be given to outstanding achievements in the field of sports.

04. Applications of candidates who do not fulfill the requirement of para. 02 will be rejected. On arrival for the first interview the height will be measured. Candidates whose height is below the standard specified in the *Gazette* Notification and who have no exceptional skill will not be interviewed.

05. *Conditions of service.* - The following conditions of service will apply to a cadet entry :

- (a) The candidate is to initially enlist in the Air Force as a cadet on a regular engagement in the same manner as for other ranks and will undergo a Basic Training Course. On successful completion of basic training the duration of which will depend on the branch of service the cadet is allocated his enlistment as an other rank will lapse and he will receive a permanent Commission in the rank of Pilot Officer ;
- (b) Cadets will be required to undergo training at a place in Sri Lanka or abroad as decided by the Commander of the Air Force in consultation with the Ministry of Defence ;
- (c) During the period of training as Cadets and thereafter personnel will be subject to Air Force Law ;
- (d) Every Cadet will be provided all items of uniforms equipment and medical facilities.
- (e) During the period of training a Cadet will be accommodated in an Air Force Mess and will be provided with food ;
- (f)
 - (i) In the event of a Cadet voluntarily terminating his candidature for a Commission during training the parent or guardian will be required to refund to the Republic of Sri Lanka all expenses incurred up to that time by the Republic of Sri Lanka on account of such Cadet.
 - (ii) If at any time during his course a Cadet is reported by the authorities as being unsuitable for reasons of misconduct or due to causes within his control to qualify for a commission, his parent or guardian will be required to refund to the Sri Lanka Air Force all expenses incurred on his training and

will be required to enter into a bond to this effect with the Commander of the Air Force acting on behalf of the Government of Sri Lanka ;

- (g) Parent or guardian will sign a declaration as given in cage 20 of the application form in respect of Sub paragraphs (f) (i) & (ii) above and forward them together with the application. Parent or guardian will be required to enter into a bond subsequently in this form with the Republic of Sri Lanka prior to the appointment of these candidates as Cadets ;
- (h) Candidates who possess the requirement as per para. 02 will be called for the preliminary interview and if successful will be called for the Officer Quality Tests. Candidates who pass the Officer Quality Tests will be called for Medical Examinations and if applicable Flying Aptitude Tests. Candidates who successfully complete these tests will be called for the Final Interview. The required numbers of candidates per Branch will be selected according to merit at these interviews and tests.

06. *Official Language Requirements.* - The selected candidates will be required to comply with any rules already made or may hereafter be made for giving effect to the Language Policy of the Republic of Sri Lanka and in particular for implementing the provisions the Official Language Act, No. 33 of 1956.

07.(a) Pay for Officer Cadets and Commissioned Officers in the Sri Lanka Air Force are laid down as below : -

Cadet -Rs. 76,320 p.a.

Pilot Officer - Rs. 85,680 p.a.

Flying Officer -Rs. 1,12,500 - 9 x 2,700 Rs. 1,36,800 = p.a.

Flight Lieutenant -Rs. 1,28,700 - 9 x 2,700-Rs. 15,300 = p.a.

Squadron Leader -Rs. 1,44,900 - 7 x 2,700 - 1 x 3,000-2x = 4,500 Rs. 1,75,800 p.a.

Wing Commander -Rs. 1,53,540 - 2 x 5,520 - 5 x 6,120-Rs. 195,180 p.a.

Group Captain -Rs. 1,97,520 - 7 x 9,000 =Rs. 260,520 p. a.

(b) *Other Allowances:-*

- (i) Incentive allowance of Rs. 250 p. m. after five years of Service ;
- (ii) Hardlying allowances Rs. 600 ;
- (iii) Enhanced Allowance Rs. 3,000 p. m. for those serving in operational areas (Rs. 100 will be paid for each working day at only Jaffna Peninsula) ;
- (iv) Uniform upkeep allowances Rs. 255 per month ;
- (v) Batman Allowances Rs. 637.50 per month ;
- (vi) Ration allowance Rs. 5,074.39 per month (If permitted to live out) ;
- (vii) Qualification pay where applicable (up to a maximum of Rs. 637.50 per month) ;
- (viii) 03 sets of holiday railway warrants per year (for officer, spouse and children) ;
- (ix) An additional set of railway warrants or the reimbursement of bus fare for officers living in Messes to travel from the Mess to the hometown once a month ;

- (x) Free issue of uniforms and ancillary items ;
- (xi) Free medical facilities (including for families if applicable) ;
- (xii) Married Officers permitted to live - out are entitled to a free bus pass to travel to place of work within 30 miles radius ;
- (xiii) Flying pay (upto a maximum of Rs 340 - 1700 per month) for those in the General Duties Pilot Branch) ;
- (xiv) Following rent allowances are payable to married Officers not in occupation of a Government married quarter.

Pilot Officer to Group Captain and Above Rs. 1,500- Rs. 3,850 per month.

08. Pensions/Gratuities are payable in terms of the Air Force Pensions & Gratuities Code 1981 as amended from time to time. All Officers are contributors to the Widows' and Orphans' Pension (Armed Forces) Scheme. Rate of contributions are as per Widows' and Orphans' Pension (Armed Forces) Scheme Regulations 1970.

09. A single officer is required to live in the Officers, Mess. He is provided with furnished accommodation and food. Batman service will be provided. A single officer's Ration Allowance and Batman Allowance are paid to the Mess.

10. A married officer may be provided with a married quarter if available. Recovery of rental will be as applicable to public servants.

11. All officers are liable to be posted for duty or training in any part of the world at any time.

12. All Officers are governed by the Air Force Act and orders issued from time to time.

13. Instructions to applicants:-

- (a) Applications should be submitted in applicants own hand writing in terms of the form specified below. All cages of the application should be completed neatly with as much details as possible. Applications should be forwarded under registered cover to : "Chief Recruiting Officer "Sri Lanka Air Force, Ekala, Kotugoda" so as to reach him not later than 1200 noon on 30th April, 2004. The envelope enclosing the application should be marked "Application for Cadetship in Branch". Applications received after the closing date and not in accordance with the requirements of this notification and not in registered post mail will not be entertained.
- (b) Candidates who are in Government Service/Corporations/Boards/Civil Establishments should forward their applications through their Heads of Departments/Corporations/Boards/Civil Establishments and should bear a certificate to the effect that the candidate will be released if selected.

(c) Candidates will be required to produce the originals of the following documents when summoned for interviews or when called upon to do so :-

- (i) Certificate of Registration of Birth (Certificate issued for the purpose of the education code will not be accepted) ;
- (ii) Certificates in support of the educational qualifications required for the Branch applied for ;
- (iii) Certificates of trade/technical training and/or experience (if any obtained from a recognized institution ;
- (iv) Two recent certificates of character.— One of these should be from the principal of the last school attended and the other from the responsible person who has the know of the applicant for more than two years or from the present employer (if employed) ;
- (v) Certificate in support of sports activities cadeting etc. ;

(d) Applications of candidates who fail to produce documents when requested to do so will not be considered.

(e) No documents or original copies of documents should be attached to the application form.

(f) The Air Force will not be responsible for loss of any originals of certificates if enclosed with the application form.

14. Any statement in the application, which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection and for dismissal if discovered after the selection.

15. *Selection Interviews etc.*— Preliminary selections will be made amongst those candidates who fulfil the above conditions. Candidates so selected will be required to undergo tests as may be prescribed by the Commander of the Air Force. The final selection will then be made after an interview of those selected candidates, by a selection board appointed by the Ministry of Defence.

16. Candidates selected for interviews will be informed in writing of the place, time and date of such interviews. Travelling or other expenses will not be paid in this respect.

17. On every occasion an applicant is summoned for an interview he is to produce his National Identity Card issued by the Department of Registration of Persons.

18. Candidates likely to be suitable following their final interviews will be required to present themselves before an Air Force Medical Board.

19. Any one who desires to recommend a candidate should do so by giving his testimonial. Any form of canvassing or attempt to influence in the selection of a candidate will result in disqualification of such candidate.

20. Candidates who are found unsuitable for enlistment will not be notified.

APPLICATIONS are invited from those between 18 - 35 year of age who wish to study for the Course of Diploma in Sports to be conducted in Sinhala by the National Institute of Sports Science of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports.

01. Note : (i) The age limit is not relevant to those who are already in Public Service. Incorrect applications will be rejected.
(ii) Applications not completed properly will have to be rejected.

02. Educational and Other Qualifications :

2.1 Should have passed in 6 subjects at G. C. E. (Ordinary Level) Examination or Equivalent Examination in not more than two sittings. However 2 Subjects out of the 6 Subjects passed should be Sinhala or Tamil and Mathematics or Arithmetic.

2.2 Further he or she should have :

- (a) Successfully completed a course at a recognized Government institution of Sports or Physical Education of at least 6 months duration ; or
(b) At least one year service as a Sports Officer attached to the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports or

Provincial Councils or special achievements in sports with at least 3 years service as a Teacher of Sports in Government School or as an Instructor/Instructors in sports of a Local Government Institution ; or

- (c) Successfully completed the course in Sports or Physical Education of at least 3 months duration in the Army, Navy or Air Force training school (could be considered for selection even if not qualified under 2.1) ; or
(d) Being a member of a National Sports Team taken part in competition at international level ; or
(e) Obtained first, second or third place in individual events or the National Sports Festival conducted by the Sports Ministry ; or

first or second places in team championship or first or second place in individual events at inter district competition of this festival and or first place in team events or first, second or third place in National level competition conducted by a Sports Federation or first place in a National or Public schools competition.
