VACANCIES exist in the Sri Lanka Regular and Volunteer Air Force for Direct Entry Commissioned Officers in the following branches.

- (a) Technical Signal Branch - (Regular Force)
- (b) Air Field Construction Branch - (Regular Force)
- (c) Medical Branch - (Regular / Volunteer Force)
- (d) Dental Branch - (Regular / Volunteer Force)
- (e) Administrative Veterinary Branch - (Regular Force)

02. Applications are invited from candidates who possess the professional qualifications given below.

(a) Technical Signal Branch:-

- (i) *Electronic and Telecommunication Engineering Officers:*
BSc Degree in Electronics/Telecommunications Engineering or NDT in Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering or equivalent qualifications.

- (ii) *System Analyst / Programmers:*
BSc (Special) Degree in Computer Science or

BSc Degree in Computer Science/BSc Degree with Computer Science as a subject / Bachelor of Information Technology from a recognized University. (Experience in programming in any of the listed Packages/Languages will be an added advantage) or

Passes in six subjects at the GCE O/L Examination with four credits including a credit in Mathematics (Mathematics II if an applicant of 1999/2000 years) and ordinary passes in Science (Science II if an applicant of 1999/2000 years), Sinhala/Tamil and English Languages in one sitting and ordinary passes in three subjects (Physical Science) at the GCE A/L (New / Old syllabus) examination in one sitting and

NIBM Diploma / BCS part I or Higher / ACS in all four parts with at least 02 years programming experience in Developer 2000 or Visual Basic for Oracle RDBMS or Java or C++ or any Visual Language.

(b) Air Field Construction Branch :

- (i) *Civil Engineering Officers.*—BSc Degree in Civil Engineering or NDT in Civil Engineering or equivalent qualifications (Preference will be given to those who are with structural design experience)
- (ii) *Electrical Engineering Officers.*—BSc Degree in Electrical Engineering or NDT in Electrical Engineering or equivalent qualifications.
- (iii) *Quantity Surveyors.*—BSc Degree in Quantity Surveying or equivalent qualifications.

(c) *Medical Branch:-*

- (i) *Medical Officer.*—The minimum qualification required is MBBS or equivalent and be fully registered with the Sri Lanka Medical Council Specialist or higher qualifications will be an added advantage for Selection.
- (ii) *Assistant Medical Officer.*—Successful completion of the prescribed course of Assistant Medical Officers conducted by the Sri Lanka Medical Council with the internship and certificate of efficiency as Assistant Medical Officer issued by the Sri Lanka Medical Council.
- (iii) *Registered Medical Officer.*—Registration certificate of Sri Lanka Medical Council as Registered Medical Officer.

(d) *Dental Branch: -*

Dental Officer.—The minimum qualification required is BDS or equivalent from a recognized University with full registration with the Sri Lanka Medical Council. Specialist or higher qualifications will be an added advantage for selection.

(e) *Administrative Veterinary Branch :*

Veterinary Officer.—The minimum qualification required is Bachelor of Veterinary Sciences from the University of Peradeniya or equivalent and be fully registered with the Sri Lanka Veterinary Council.

Other Requirements :

- (i) Technical Signal Branch—Male, age not more than 28 years as at 30th June 2004,
- (ii) Air Field Construction Branch - Male, age not more than 35 years as at 30th June 2004,
- (iii) Medical Branch - Male/Female, age not more than 35 years as at 30th June 2004,
- (iv) Dental Branch - Male / Female, age not more than 35 years as at 30th June 2004,
- (v) Administrative Veterinary Branch - Male, Age not more than 35 years as at 30th June 2004,

Sri Lankan citizen.

Height : Male 5'5" and Females 5' 2" and above.

03. Any candidate who may have a special skill or value to the service may at the discretion of the Commander of the Air Force be considered, even though he may not have the requisite age or height or chest measurements provided he/she possesses the requisite academic and professional qualifications.

04. Be medically fit so as to pass such medical examinations as may be prescribed by the Commander of the Air Force.

05. Due consideration will be given to current outstanding achievements in the field of sports.

06. Selected candidates will be granted a Regular or Volunteer Commission in the Sri Lanka Air Force in the Pilot Officer, Flying Officer or Flight Lieutenant rank (candidates in the Dental and Administrative Veterinary Branches in the rank of Flight Lieutenant) in keeping with their qualifications and experience.

07. *Official Language Requirements.*—Selected candidates will be required to comply with any rules already made or may hereafter be made for giving effect to the Language Policy of the Republic of Sri Lanka and in particular for implementing the provisions the Official Language Act, No 33 of 1956.

08. The selected candidates will be required to undergo training at such places as decided by the Commander of the Air Force. If at any time during training the officer is reported on by the authorities as being unsuitable for reasons of misconduct or due to causes within his control, he will be liable to have his Commission withdrawn and/ or be subject to other disciplinary action in accordance with Sri Lanka Air Force Disciplinary Regulations.

09. The conditions of services of an Officer of the Sri Lanka Air Force are in terms of Sri Lanka Air Force Regulations published in the *Gazette* No. 10,240 of 27th April, 1951, and as amended from time to time. Interm of section 10 of the Air Force Act, "Every Officer shall hold his appointment during the President's pleasure". However an Officer has no right to resign his Commission unilaterally but under provision of section II of the Air Force Act, may be allowed by the President to do so. The provisions of any Bond/ Agreement envisaging a period of obligatory service in respect of training and subsequent courses will not supercede the provisions of Section II of the Air Force Act, stated above. Retirement from the Air Force will be applicable after 10 years service under conditions specified in the Air Force Pensions and Gratuities Code.

10. All officers are liable to be posted for duty or training in any part of the world at any time.

11. A single Officer is required to live in the Officers Mess. He is provided with furnished accommodation and food Batman service will be provided. A single Officer's ration allowance and batman allowance are paid to the mess.

12. A married Officer may be provided with a married quarters if available. Recovery of rental will be as applicable to public servants. Married Officers not in occupation of married quarters will be entitled to a rental allowance as stated in para. 14 (b) (13).

13. All Officers are Governed by the Air Force Act and orders issued from time to time.

15. Pensions/Gratuities are payable in terms of the Air Force Pensions & Gratuities code 1981 as amended from time to time. All Officers are contributors to the Widows and Orphans Pension (Armed Forces) Scheme. Rates of contributions are as per Widows and Orphans Pension (Armed Forces) Scheme Regulations 1970.

16. Instructions to Applicants :

- (a) Applications should be submitted in applicants own hand writing in terms of the form specified below. All cages of the application should be completed neatly with as much details as possible. Applications should be addressed to:

The envelope enclosing the application should be marked “Application for Commission in the Branch” Applications received after the closing date and not in accordance with the requirements of this notification and not in registered post mail will not be entertained.

- (b) Candidates who are in Government service/ Corporations/ Boards/Civil Establishments should forward their

applications through their Heads of Department/Corporations/Boards/Civil Establishments & should bear a certificate to the effect that the candidate will be released if selected.

(c) Applicants should attach to their applications copied of:

- (i) Certificate of Registration of Birth
- (ii) Certificates of the highest academic and professional qualifications obtained
- (iii) Certificates of Character from at least two responsible persons who are personally acquainted with the applicant.
- (iv) Certificates in support of sports activities, cadeting, etc.
- (v) Certificate in support of any claims made in the application.

Originals of these certificates should be produced only if and when the applicant is called for the interview.

17. *Selection Interviews etc.*—Preliminary selections will be made amongst those candidates who fulfils the above conditions only. Candidates so selected will be required to undergo tests as may be prescribed by the commander of the Air Force. The final selection will then be made after an interview of those selected candidates, by a selection board appointed by the Ministry of Defence. Candidates selected for interviews will be informed in writing of the place, time and date of such interviews. No Travelling or other expenses will be paid in this respect.

18. Any one who desires to recommend a candidate should do so by giving his testimonial. Any form of canvassing or attempt to influence in the selection of a candidate will result in disqualification of such candidate.

19. Any statement in the application which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection and to dismissal if discovered after the selection.
