SALE OF TODDY RENTS IN THE RATNAPURA DISTRICT - 2005

Pinnawala Toddy Tavern No. 02

TENDERS are hereby invited for selling fermented toddy by retails referred to in the areas of below subschedule here to attached during the period of 01st January, 2005 to 31st December, 2005.

In here it should be made conformity with following conditions.

- (i) In accordance with toddy rent sale conditions appearing in the *Gazette* No. 207 of 20th August, 1982 and
- (ii) The common conditions applicable to all licenses in the notice of excise

(2) Every tender should be submitted the receipt of cash deposited from Divisional Secretariat/Bank of Ceylon/District Secretariat. It should be deposited 500 Rupees for Pinnawala Toddy Tavern No. 2

(3) The prescribed form obtainable at any of the Divisional Secretariat, Excise Department Office at Colombo and duly perfected tender forms should be placed in a sealed envelopes on the top left hand corner of which should be clearly marked. "Tender for Pinnawala Toddy Tavern No. 2".
