FOREIGN LIQUOR TAVERN RENT SALES FOR THE YEAR 2005 NEGOMBO DIVISIONAL SECRETARY'S DIVISION

TENDERS are accepted for the selling of foreign liquor from 01st January, 2005 to 31st December, 2005 in a suitable place approved by the Government with the following conditions :—

- (i) Conditions laid down in *Gazette of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka* No. 207 of 20.08.1982 for the selling of foreign liquor taverns ;
- (ii) General Conditions valid regarding Excise Licenses.

02. Tenders should be sent in the specified form obtainable from any Divisional Secretariat in the country. The amount shown in the Column (f) below should be paid to the Divisional Secretary and the receipt obtained for the such amount, should be attached to the tender form with Worth Certificate if the property is not sold for the issue of such Worth Certificate, it is valid for 5 years from the date of issue. A new Worth Certificate should be submitted along with the tender form in the event the validity period of the Worth Certificate expires during the year or otherwise additional Worth Certificate should be produced at least 30 days before the expiry of the rent period.

03. "The tender form for foreign liquor taverns for the year, 2005 No. 02 in the Negombo Divisional Secretariat Division" should be written on the top left-hand corner of the envelope carrying the tender form and submitted within the specified time.

04. Tenderers should be present at the Negombo Divisional Secretariat at the time of accepting tenders.

05. The names of the successful tenderers will be announced soon after the opening of tenders. The buyer should deposit a sum of money as a security as per the Conditions of Foreign Liquor Sale Conditions.

06. The successful tenderer will be informed to attend the office to sign the agreement. Failure to do so will be deemed to have forfeited his claim to the tender deposit and will be entered in the default tenderers list. The tender deposit of other tenderers will be refunded after signing the agreement by the successful tenderer.

07. I hold sole authority to refuse any or all tenders without giving any reasons.

08. Availability of the present premises to continue for the year 2005 cannot be guaranteed. My prior approval should be obtained before selecting of the venue of the tavern.

09. Foreign liquor taverns will be sold again on 24.11.2004 at 10.30 a.m. (only those failed to auction on 29.09.2004).
