

(b) Class II, Segment "A" — Rs. 73,440 - 1x 1,320 - 13x1,560- Rs. 95,040 per annum. Appointees should pass efficiency bar examination before they reach the salary step of Rs. 76,320 in addition, they should pass the Second Departmental Examination for promotion.

(c) Class I - Rs. 89,160 - 13x1,560 - 5x2,460 - Rs. 1,21,740 per annum.

(d) Special Class - Rs. 107,580 - 15x2,460 - Rs. 1,44,480 per annum.

03. *Age Limit.*—Should be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years. The upper age limit will not apply to those who are already in the Public Service.

04. (1) The applicants should possess the following qualification :

- (i) National Diploma in Technology awarded by the University of Moratuwa or Hardy Technical College, Ampara ;
- (ii) National Diploma in Engineering awarded by the National Apprentice and Industrial Training Authority ; or
- (iii) National Diploma in Advanced Engineering awarded by the Ministry of Tertiary Educations ; or
- (iv) Diploma in Technology awarded by the Open University ;
- (v) Certificate for passing the first part of the Engineering Examination conducted by the Sri Lanka Institute of Engineers ; or
- (vi) Any other qualification certified to the effect that it is accepted by the Sri Lanka Technical Services Board as equivalent to above technical qualifications.

05. *Professional Knowledge and Experience.*— (i) Every applicant, after having obtained above qualifications, should possess at least two years experience in the related field at supervisory level in a Government Institute or Corporation/Statutory Board or in a recognized Motor Garage which is registered under Companies Act and where at least 10 employees are paid Employees Provident Fund and Employees Trust Fund ; and

(ii) Should possess a driving licence for all motor coaches and motor bicycles.

06. *Method of Recruitment.*— Applicants will be selected in order of the highest marks scored at a public examination conducted only in Colombo and subsequently, they will be subject to an interview and recruitment will be made in accordance with the Circular No. 15/90 of 09.03.1990, relevant Public Administration circulars issued later and provisions in the Establishments Code. This Competitive Examination will consist of a question paper of one hour duration on intelligence test and one question paper of two hours duration on general knowledge of Motor Mechanism. Candidates should appear for the two question papers in one language medium.

- (i) Intelligence Test (Aptitude) - Duration 01 hour a Multiple Choice question paper — 100 marks.

This question paper is prepared to evaluate language and numerical skills, power of reasoning and general intelligence.

- (ii) General knowledge of Motor Mechanism duration 02 hours— 100 marks.

Applicant should possess a basic knowledge of the following technical fields and a fundamental understanding of the faults relating to such fields :

- (01) Function and power in-put of a diesel and petrol engine ;
- (02) Clutch and transmission system ;
- (03) Lubricating system and cooling system ;
- (04) Electric system ;
- (05) Fuel systems of petrol and diesel vehicles ;
- (06) Foot brake system, Inspection of testing equipment for howler effectiveness, reaction time, stopping distance ;
- (07) Hand brake system ;
- (08) Testing equipment for wheel alignment and steering geometry ;
- (09) Suspension system ;
- (10) Preparation of condition report for a vehicle ;
- (11) Issue of Fitness Certificate for a vehicle ;
- (12) General knowledge of the functions in the Department and the duties of a Motor Vehicle Examiner ;
- (13) General understanding of painting, welding and fitting ;
- (14) Automatic transmission.

07. *Terms of Engagement and Conditions of Service.*—(i) The posts are permanent and is entitled to the pension under Contributed Pension Fund. You are required to contribute 08% of your monthly consolidated salary, should be paid to the Contributed Pension Fund from the date of your appointment. If the applicants who are already in the public Service are selected he will be appointed on an acting basis for a specified period.

(ii) Appointees will be required to serve in any part of the Island (including North and East) ;

(iii) Sections in Paras. 10 and 12 in Chapter II in the Establishment Code will apply as appropriate to the post.

(iv) Subsequent to efficiency bars promotions depend on passing language test (oral), first and second Departmental examinations.

(v) Reference is invited to the General Conditions applicable to appointments in the public Service published at the beginning of Part I : Section II (A) of this *Gazette*.

08. The application perfected by the applicant in his own handwriting should be attached the copies (not originals) of the following certificates :

- (a) Certificate of Birth (*N.B.*—Affidavits, Baptismal Certificates or certificates issued for the purpose of regulations pertaining to Assisted Schools will not be entertained).

- (c) Certificate relating to practical training obtained from the motor garage where training has been received.
- (d) Recent certificate obtained from the Grama Niladhari. This certificate should have been compulsorily counter signed by the Divisional Secretary.
- (e) Two recent certificate of applicant's character and his eligibility for this post.
- (N.B.—Copies of the certificates will not be returned).

09. *Examination Fees.*—Examination fee is Rs. 250.

- (a) This fee may be paid to any District Secretariat/ Divisional Secretariat or at the Shroff Counter of this Department to be credited to the Head of Public Revenue Account (2003-40-00). The receipt issued for the payment of fees should be well affixed on the reverse of the last page of the application.

10. If the applications which have been forwarded through the Heads of Department received at this Office after due date they will be accepted if the Heads of Departments recommend adducing reasons for the acceptance of such applications which have been received by them on or before due date. Further the Heads of Departments who forward applications should indicate whether the applicants could be released if they are selected.

11. *Place of Examination.*—This examination will be conducted only in Colombo. Examination will be held in November 2004. Travelling expenses or any other allowance will not be paid by the Government for attending the examination or in lieu.

12. *Candidates' Identity.*—Candidates will be required to prove their identity to the satisfaction of the Supervisor. For this purpose any one of the following documents will be accepted :

- (i) a National Identity Card issued by the Department of Registration of Persons ;
- (ii) a Passport ;
- (iii) a valid Identity Card issued by the Postmaster-General.

13. *Provision of Inaccurate Information.*—If it is revealed that a candidate does not possess qualifications, his candidature may be cancelled. After selection if it is disclosed that a candidate has knowingly furnished any inaccurate information or he has purposely changed by important matter he is liable to dismissal from the Public Service.

14. My decision with regard to any matter which is not referred to in this notification will be the final decision.

15. Admission cards will be issued to the candidates considering that they have fulfilled basic qualification contained in this *Gazette Notification* and the issue of an admission card should not be considered as acceptance of an eligibility for this post.
