Recruitment to the Post of Public Health Veterinary Officer

APPLICATIONS are invited from the citizens of Sri Lanka with following qualifications for the post of Public Health Veterinary Officer in the Department of Health Services. Applications prepared as per form of specimen appended to this letter should be sent to reach the following address before 17.01.2005. The applicants who are already in the service should submit their applications through the relevant Heads of Institutions.

02. Educational and other qualifications :

- Should be graduate holding a Veterinary Degree from a recognized University.
- Should have registered as a Veterinary Officer of Sri Lanka.
- Ability to attend to duties in English Language.

03. *Age Limit.*— Should be not less than 18 and not more than 45 years of age. (The maximum age limit will not apply for those who are already in the service).

04. *Salary Scale.*— Class II, Grade II—Rs. 112,500 — 15 x 2,700 — Rs. 153,000. In terms of salary group TA-5-1-2 of the PA Circular No. 15/2003.

05. *Efficiency Bar Examinations.*— Applicants should pass the first Efficiency Bar Examination within 03 years from the date of first appointment (before reaching the salary step of Rs. 120,600 of the relevant salary scale).

Method of Recruitment.— Recruitments will be made based on the merit order of a competitive examination. The subjects of examination are as follows :

- Aptitude Test.*— Time : 01 hour - Marks 100.
- Subject Related Question Paper.*—Time - 02 hours — Marks 100 (candidates should secure minimum of 40% marks for each subject).

06. *Terms of Engagement.*— The post is permanent. Should contribute to the Contributory Pension Scheme.

07. *Method of Application.*— Applications should be sent to the following address. The words “Application for the post of Public Health Veterinary Officer” should be written on the top left hand

corner of the envelope enclosing the application, As per order of the Public Service Commission.

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JUDICIAL SERVICE COMMISSION

Posts of President, Labour Tribunal—Grade II

APPLICATIONS are invited for posts of President, Labour Tribunal, Grade II.

02. Applications on forms obtainable from this Office may be made by persons having the requisite qualifications to reach me on or before 17.01.2005.

Note.—(1) Requests for application forms by post should be accompanied by self-addressed stamped envelope not smaller than 9" x 4" in size.

(2) To ensure that applications are duly received at this Office, applicants are advised either to hand over the application personally or to send them by registered post.

03. *Salary Scale.*—Rs. 155,100—7 x 5,520—Rs. 193,740. (This salary scale is subject to the revision implemented by Circular No. : 15/2003 dated 30.12.2003).

04. Every applicant must be :—

- (a) of excellent moral character and physically fit ; and
- (b) a citizen of Sri Lanka.

05. *Qualifications.*—A person shall be eligible for appointment as a President, Labour Tribunal, Grade II. if he is —

- (a) An Officer in Class II Grade I or Grade II of the Judicial Service of Sri Lanka ; or

- (b) an Attorney-at-Law who has been in active practice for not less than three years with experience in labour matters ; or
- (c) an Attorney-at-Law who has served in a legal capacity in any Ministry or Government Department or a State Corporation for not less than four years ; or
- (d) an Attorney-at-Law who has served in a legal capacity in any Legal Firm, Bank or any recognized Mercantile Establishment for not less than four years ; or
- (e) an Attorney-at-Law who has been in a staff-post in the Public Service or in a recognized mercantile establishment for not less than four years and has had experience in the administration of labour laws and labour relations ; or
- (f) an Attorney-at-Law who has been a Teacher of Law in a recognized University or Law School for not less than four years ; or
- (g) an Attorney-at-Law in the Public Service or in a State Corporation for not less than fifteen years and has had experience in the administration of labour laws and in labour relations.

06. Applicants will be required to produce any or all of the following documents when called upon to do so :

- (a) Certificate of Birth ;
- (b) Highest educational certificate ;
- (c) Certificates of professional qualifications ; and
- (d) Certificates of highest examination passed in Sinhala/Tamil.

07. Applications from officers in the Public Service must be forwarded through the Heads of Departments.

08. Application and any other communications relating thereto must be addressed to the Secretary, Judicial Service Commission and not to any other officer in this office.

09. Applications will be acknowledged. If any applicant does not receive an acknowledgement within one week, he should notify the Secretary, Judicial Service Commission.
