THE item 4 in Section 2.1 in para. 02 and Section 4.3 in para. 4 of the notification relating to Programme for Training Graduates for Teaching in the English Medium in Secondary Grades in Government Schools, 2003 published in the *Gazette* No. 1,319 of 12.12.2003 of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka is hereby amended to read as follows :

4. Candidates should have passed in a minimum of two subjects out of Geography or Economics or History or Political Science or Sociology in their Degree or obtained a Special Degree in the subjects of Geography, Science, Economics, History, Sociology, Commerce.
