Two Year Diploma Course in Social Work Sinhala/Tamil Medium 2004/2006

NATIONAL Institute of Social Development entertains applications for admission to the Diploma in Social Work - 2004/2006. This Diploma Programme aims to train personnel in Social Work Practice for Social Development and also Auction and Social Welfare Administration.

01. Eligibility for Admission :

- (i) A pass in G.C.E. (A/L) with eligibility to enter the University in the relevant academic year; or
- (ii) Other than the above qualifications a candidate who has advanced educational qualifications and having not less than 03 years of experience in the field of Social Welfare/Social Development; or
- (iii) (a) Who has completed not less than three years satisfactory service in Government, Provincial Councils or Local Government Service in the following categories :-
 - (i) teachers of Provincial Councils or Ministry of Education and Higher Education;

- (ii) Social Development Assistant of Ministry of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources;
- (iii) Colonization officers of land Commissioner's Department;
- (iv) Public Health Nurses, Public Health Inspectors, Psychiatric Social Workers of the Health Department;
- (v) Relief Officers, Local Government Officers, Community Development Officers of the Local Government Commission and Local Government Department;
- (vi) Rural Development Officers, Assistant Rural Development Officers of the Rural Development Department;
- (vii) Grama Niladharis of Ministry of Public Administration and Home Affairs;
- (viii) Social Service Officers of Provincial Councils, Social Services Department and Poor Relief Department;
- (ix) Probation Officers, Head Masters, House Masters and Assistant house Masters in Certified School of the Probation and Child care Services Department;
- (x) Jailers and Welfare Officers of Prison Department;
- (xi) Cooperative Development Officers/Inspectors of Cooperative Development;
- (b) District youth Officers of youth Services Officers and Assistant Youth Service Officers of the National Youth Services Council;

- (c) Welfare Officers, Community Development Officers in Government Boards, corporations, Private Sector, Industrial and Plantation Sector;
- (d) Officers who hold similar posts in Government, Non-Government and Private Sector;
- (e) Who have obtained qualifications deemed to be equivalent to either of the above qualification by the Academic Committee of the National Institute of Social Development.

Note: (i) Preference will be given to those who have higher educational qualifications and/or wider experience in the field of Social Welfare and Social Development.

- (ii) A Credit Pass in English in G.C.E. (O/L) will be an added qualification.

02. Age :

The candidates should be above 20 years and below 46 years of age on the date fixed for closing application.

03. OTHER CONDITIONS :

- (i) Since this is a full time course of Two Year duration, applicants who are employed or following other courses of studies will have to obtain 2 year leave. **The responsibility of obtaining such leave lies absolutely with the applicant.**
- (ii) Permission will not be granted to all students to follow any other course of study during the duration of this course. If a student is detected to follow any other course that student would be dismissed from this course.

- (a) First year.—Through an 800 hours Field Placement, students are given Practical Training in the Social Work Methods they learn in the class room.
- (b) Second Year.—Students are expected to plan and implement a social Development project.

05. Awarding the Diploma :

The diploma will be awarded to be students who fulfill the following requirements :-

- (a) Pass in all subjects mentioned above including Social Development Project and Field Instruction.
- (b) Full attendance for course work and be of excellent conduct satisfying the Examination board of the National Institute of Social Development as to the students suitability for awarding the Diploma.

06. Methods of Selection :

The applicants who have the qualifications mentioned above will be called for a written examination. This examination Centers will be in Matara, Coolombo, Kandy, Anuradhapura, Vavuniya and Ampara. (Those Centers which do not have sufficient number of candidates, would be cancelled and attached to the Center nearest to them). Those who have passed the examination will be summoned for an interview. Final selection will be made by the admission Committee of the Institute.
