Vacancies in Police Hospital, Colombo - Posts of Medical Officer

APPLICATIONS are invited by the Sri Lanka Police Reserve from citizens of Sri Lanka for the above Posts in the Police Hospital, Colombo.

01. Applications prepared in accordance with the specimen form given below should be sent by registered post to reach the Director/Recruitment, Sri Lanka Police Reserve Headquarters, No. 15, Malalasekara Mawatha, Colombo 07 on or before 21.08.2004. Applications received thereafter will be rejected. The post, which you apply for, should be written on the top left hand corner of the envelope. Preference will be given to those applicants who are in Government Service at present.

02. Educational & Professional Qualifications :

- MBBS (SL) or equivalent medical degree; and permanent and full registration by the Sri Lanka Medical Council.
- Preference will be given to candidates who have undergone special professional training and/or experience in the fields relevant to the present requirements of the Police Hospital. eg; Intensive Care Unit Work, Paediatrics.

03. Salary, & other allowances and Facilities :

- The selected candidate will be entitled to receive the Health Department Salary with due increments and allowances. In addition he or she will receive some of the allowances due to the mobilized officers of the Police Reserve.
- An official Car and a Driver will be provided.

04. Other Terms of Employment :

- The selected candidate will be enlisted and mobilized as RASP/RWASP, in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Sri Lanka Police Reserve.
- The selected candidate will continue to maintain his or her service seniority in the Health Department.
- The selected candidate will have to serve a probationary period of one year. And he/she will be kept mobilized for service for a period of four years.

05. Conditions of Service :

- The selected candidates will be required to comply with any rules already made or may hereafter be made to give effect to the official language policy of the Government.
- Candidates will be subject to the regulations stipulated in the Establishments Code, the Police Departmental Orders

and the regulations issued from time to time by the Inspector General of Police or by the Government.

- The applicants should attach copies of the following documents to their applications (Originals should not be attached).
 - Birth Certificate,
 - Certificates confirming the Educational Qualifications,
 - Professional Certificates,
 - Certificates regarding the professional experience.
- Applicants must fill the required particulars in their own hand-writing on papers 11" x 8" in size and post them, together with copies of the certificates called for, to the address given in paragraph 2 above. Under no circumstance should the applications be handed over personally to any officer in the Police Department.
- Applicants selected, should pass a Medical Examination prior to appointment. Those who are found unsuitable for the Police Service will be rejected.

Note.—All applications, which do not conform to the requirements stipulated in this notification, will be rejected and such applicants will not be notified. Travelling expenses will not be paid to candidates who are summoned to appear for tests and interviews in respect of the above.
