01. Salary Scale :

- 01.1 Annual consolidated salary for this post is ;

(The salary will be paid according to P.A. Circular
No. 15/2003)

02. Qualifications :

- 02.1 Every applicant should be a citizen of Sri Lanka.
02.2 Not less than 22 years and not more than 45 years of age as at 15.04.2004
(The maximum age limit will not be applicable to those employed in the Public Service/Provincial Public Service)
02.3 An Attorney-at-Law of the Supreme Court with not less than 02 years experience.

03. Method of Recruitment :

- 03.1 Selection will be made by a duly constituted Interview Board.
03.2 The appointments will be made by the Public Service Commission.

04. Conditions of Service :

- 04.1 All posts are permanent and entitled to Contributory Pension under the Contributory Pension Scheme. Contribution of 08% from monthly remuneration should be made to the Pensions Scheme.

05. Conditions for Engagement in Service :

- 05.1 Should comply with the Provisions of the Establishment Code, Financial Regulations of the Commission and any other rules and regulations imposed by Government from time to time.

06. Those already employed in the Public Service should sent their applications through their respective Heads of Department.

07. Applicants should furnish following documents when called upon to do so :
