ANTIQUITIES ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 188)

REGULATION made by the Minister of Human Resources Development, Education and Cultural Affairs under Section 24 of the Antiquities Ordinance (Chapter 188).

Regulation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Antiquities (Prohibition or Restriction of Buildings and Mining), regulation No. 1 of 2004, and shall come into operation on 17th March, 2004.

2. No person shall erect buildings or carry on mining, quarrying and blasting operations on any land, within the distance of 200 yards of any ancient monument or any protected monument specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. The Provisions of Part IV of the regulations, made under section 47 of the Antiquities Ordinance (Chapter 188) and published in *Gazette* No. 8698 dated December 23, 1940, shall apply in respect of the ancient monuments and protected monuments specified in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

01. The English Fort of Ruwanwella situated on the lands depicted as lots 3, 4, and 7 of the preliminary Plan No. A 937 in the village of Ruwanwella of Dehigampal and Pahata Bulatgama Division of the Kegalle District, Sabaragamuwa Province.

02. The Kotavehera situated on the land depicted as lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the Preliminary Plan No. A 300, Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Preliminary Plan No. 757 and Lot 6 of the Preliminary Plan No. 119 in the village of Dedigama of Keeraveli Pattu in the Beligal Korale East of the Kegalle District, Sabaragamuwa Province.

03. The Kotawehera situated on the land depicted as lot 19 in the Final Village Plan No. 145 the village of Deliwela of Walgampattu in the Kinigoda Korale of the Kegalle District, Sabaragamuwa Province.

04. The Alutnuwara Devale, Sellipi Pattiruppuwa and Giruwa Ambalama situated on the land included in 55th square of 16 chains sketch No. 1/24-B in the village of Alutnuwara in Meda Pattu of Galboda Korale of the Kegalle District, Sabaragamuwa Province.

05. The rock called and known as Dewanagala on which the devanagala Rajamaha Vihare is situated in the village of Dewanagala, in Alutnuwara Wasama of the Meda Pattu in Galboda Korale of the Kegalle District, Sabaragamuwa Province.

06. The ancient Ambalama (resting Quarters for pedestrians) and rock situated in the village of Vakirigala of the Egodapattu of Galboda Korale of the Kegalle District, Sabaragamuwa Province.

07. The Fort of Menikkadawara of the Keeraveli Pattu East in Beligal Korale of the Kegalle District, Sabaragamuwa Province.

08. The sculptures, inscription and cave temple (Len Vihare) belonging to Selawa Rajamaha Vihare situated in the village of Selawa of Divisional Secretary's Division of Aaranayake of the Kegalle District, Sabaragamuwa Province.

09. The ancient Kataragama Devalaya of Uggal Alutnuwara in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Imbulpe of the Ratnapura District, Sabaragamuwa Province.

10. The old Ehelepola Walawwa situated in the Ratnapura town in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Ratnapura of the Ratnapura District, Sabaragamuwa Province.

11. The ancient sankhapala cave temple (Len Vihare) consisting 15 ancient cave temples situated in the village of Pallebedda in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Embilipitiya of the Ratnapura District, Sabaragamuwa Province.

12. The grave of Pussadeva and the drip ledged rock cave in the neighbourhood in Lot No. 214 of F. V. P. 787 of Sankhapala village situated in Pallebedda in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Embilipitiya of the Ratnapura District, Sabaragamuwa Province.

13. Historical Duch Fort situated in the village of Ratnapura in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Ratnapura of the Ratnapura District, Sabaragamuwa Province.

14. The Kataragama Devale, Pattini Devale, Lion Throne, Murutenge (Kitchen) and ancient wall situated on the land included in the 14th square of 16 chain bearing 0/512 A of Ammaduwa village in Kadavalpattu in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Atakalanppanna of the Ratnapura District, Sabaragamuwa Province.

15. The pond known as Kellange Wala situated in the village of Gelbedda in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Siyambalanduwa of the Monaragala District, Uva Province.

16. Cluster of ancient building situated on the land depicted as lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 in Preliminary Plan No. 156 and lots 1, 2, 6, 7, 8 and 11 in the Preliminary Plan No. 38 in the village of Galbedda in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Siyambalanduwa of the Monaragala District, Uva Province.

17. The cave temple (Len Vihare) of Sri Pana situated in the village of Galbedde in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Siyambalanduwa of the Monaragala District, Uva Province.

18. The rock known as buduruwagala situated in lot No. 01 in the Preliminary Plan No. 2668 of the village Medagoda in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Wellawaya of the Monaragala District, Uva Province.

19. The ancient Dighavapi dagaba situated in the village of Dighavapi in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Aaddalachchena of the Ampara District, Eastern Province.

20. Muhudu Maha Vihare situated on land depicted as lot No. 02 in the Preliminary Plan No. 1450A of the village of Potuwila in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Potuwila of the Ampara District, Eastern Province.

21. The Ancient wall situated in the premises of Magul Maha Vihare in the village of Lahugala in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Lahugala of the Ampara District, Eastern Province.

22. Ancient dagaba of Seruwila and other ancient ruins situated in the land depicted as Lot Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the Preliminary Plan No. 96 of Seruwila in the village of Toppur in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Seruwila of the Trincomalee District, Eastern Province.

23. Ancient dagaba of Tiriyaya situated in the land depicted as Lot Nos. 1, 2 and 3 of Preliminary Plan No. 132 of Tiriyaya village in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Gomarankadawala of the Trincomalee District, Eastern Province.

24. The Palace complex situated in the ancient town of Polonnaruwa in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Tamankaduwa of the Polonnaruwa District, North Central Province.

25. The Tivanka Pilimaya situated in the village of Ethumalpitiya in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Tamankaduwa of the Polonnaruwa District, North Central Province.

26. The Naipena Vihare situated in the village of Bediwewa in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Tamankaduwa of the Polonnaruwa District, North Central Province.

27. The Rankot Vehera situated in the village of Sri Nissankamallapura in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Tamankaduwa of the Polonnaruwa District, North Central Province.

28. The ancient dagaba known as Somawathie Chaitya situated in the land included in the final Topographical sheet No. 11 of the Minvillu village in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Lankapura of Meda Pattu of the Polonnaruwa District, North Central Province.

29. The ancient dagaba of Medirigiriya situated in the village of Divulankada in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Medirigiriya of the Polonnaruwa District, North Central Province.

30. Sixty four (64) drip ledged caves situated in the land called Kandegama Kanda depicted as Lot 400 in the Final Topographical Plan No. 13 (inset 49) in the village of Elavakumbura in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Dimbulagala of the Polonnaruwa District, North Central Province.

31. Ancient dagaba image house (pilimage) and wall situated in the village of Namal Pokuna in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Dimbulagala of the Polonnaruwa District, North Central Province.

32. The Gal Vihare situated in the village of Sri Nissankamallapura in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Tamankaduwa of the Pollonnaruwa District, North Central Province.

33. The Demala Maha Seya situated in the village of Sri Nissankamallapura in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Tamankaduwa of the Pollonnaruwa District, North Central Province.

34. The Katuwana Fort situated in the village of Katuwana in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Katuwana of the Hambantota District, Southern Province.

35. Mabotuwana Watta situated in the village of Mabotuwana in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Akmeemana Four Gravets of the Galle District, Southern Province.

36. The house in which the Venerable Hikkaduwa Sri Sumanagala Nayake Thero was born situated in the village of Hikkaduwa in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Hikkaduwa of the Galle District, Southern Province.

37. Ancient viharege situated in the province of Randonbe Sangharaja Purana Rajamaha Vihare in the village of Balapitiya in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Balapitiya of the Galle District, Southern Province.

38. The Kushtharajagala situated on the lands called Kushtharajagala Watta and Egodawatta in the village of Walliwela in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Weligama of the Galle District, Southern Province.

39. The Galge of Devundara situated in the lands called Galgewatta in the village of Devundara North in Divisional Secretary's Division of Devundara of the Matara District, Southern Province.

40. The Sri Vishnu Devale situated in the village of Devinuwara in the Divisional Secretary's Division of the Matara District, Southern Province.

41. The Kasagal Vihare situated in the village of Viharagoda in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Weeraketiya of the Hambantota District, Southern Province.

42. Ancient monuments situated in the premises of Naigala Purana Vihare in the land depicted as Lots 9C, 10 and 11 in the Final Village Plan No. 244 of the village of Aggrahera in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Weeraketiya of the Hambantota District, Southern Province.

43. The Purana vihare of Godawaya situated in the village of Payibokka in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Ambalantota of the Hambantota District, Southern Province.

44. The antiquities in the land called Padikemgala depicted as lots A, B. and C in sheet No. 355 of Survey Diagram No. H/SRQ/99/354 situated in the village of Mahagalwewa in Divisional Secretary's Division of Suriyawewa of the Hambantota District, Southern Province.

45. The land with antiquities depicted as Lots 120 B and 163 in the Irrigation Survey Plan No. 02 situated in the village of Tellulla in Divisional Secretary's Division of Tissamaharama of the Hambantota District, Southern Province.

46. Cave temple (Ien vihare) with wall paintings belonging to the Mulkirigala Rajamaha vihare situated in lot 163 of the Final Village Plan No. 241 of Mulkirigala village in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Weeraketiya of the Hambantota District, Southern Province.

47. The ancient chaitya of Nedigamvila situated in the village of Nedigamvila in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Tissamaharama, of the Hambantota District, Southern Province.

48. The Devuram Vehera archeological station situated in lot No. 1116 of inset 12 in the final Topographical Plan No. 03 of the village of Devuram Vehera in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Lunugam Vehera of the Hambantota District, Southern Province.

49. The land named Namaluyana in lot Nos. 19, 20, 21 and 50 in plan Nos. 1085, 1087 and 1088 situated in the village of Ihala Ulpota in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Palagala of the Anuradhapura District, North Central Province.

50. The Bodighara in the premises of dematamal Vihare in the village of Okkampitiya in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Buttala of the Monaragala District, Uva Province.

51. The Bodhisatva image of Maligawila situated in the village of Maligawila in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Tanamalwila of the Monaragala District, Uva Province.

52. The Bodhisatva image of Dambegoda situated in the village of Maligawila in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Tanamalwila of the Monaragala District, Uva Province.

53. The ancient dagaba situated downwards the Buduruwagala Wewa in the village of Medagoda in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Wellawaya of the Monaragala District, Uva Province.

54. The drip – ledged ancient caves and inscriptions situated in the premises of Koratota Rajamaha Vihare in the village of Koratota in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Kaduwela of the Colombo District, Western Province.

55. The remains of the carved ancient stone doorway and the rock boulder bearing an ancient inscription situated within the premises of Galapata Vihara lying on the land covered by sheet No. 7 Bentota Town Survey Plan No. 84 in the Village of Kahagalla in Bentota Valallavita Korale of the Galle District, in the Southern Province.

56. The Ancient citadel of Anuradhapura situated in the Gramaniladhari Division of patispura in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Nuwaragampalatha of the Anuradhapura district in the North Central Province of which the boundaries are as follows:—

South : Wasal Road; West : Anula Mawatha ; North : "Y" Road; East : Watawandana Road.
