### ESALA FESTIVAL OF RUHUNU MAHA KATARAGAMA DEVALE

ATTENTION of General Public is invited to regulation governing pilgrimages to Kataragama framed under the authority of Pilgrimage Ordinance and published in *Gazettes* No. 9859 dated 30.04.1948, No. 10000 dated 22.07.1949, No. 11255 dated 07.02.1958, No. 12508 dated 07.07.1961 and No. 12947 dated 02.03.1961 in connection there it is hereby notified that.

*Camp area*— 'Camp area' means (a) the area within a radius of a mile from the ford in the Menik Ganga at Kataragama, and (b) the area within a radius of a quarter of a mile of the Pillayar Kovil at Sella Kataragama.

#### 01. Construction of building :

No person shall contract any building or boutique whether permanent or temporary within the camp area during the period from 17th July, to 01st August, 2004 without permit issued by me or any authorize officer.

#### 02. Beggars :

No person shall beg or solicit alms within the camp area except in beggars hut situated at near the second pilgrimages, bridge over the Manik Ganga within distance of five yards

there from and no person shall distribute any alms to beggars within the camp area except at the aforesaid place.

## ANIMAL DISEASE ACT, No. 59 OF 1992

### Regulation No.5(1)

#### PROCLAMATION

03. *Bathing and washing :*

No person shall bath or wash cloths or animal from the place of water pumping to Kataragama water supply scheme to a distance three miles upwards in Manik Ganga.

04. *Vehicle :*

04.1 No person shall enter any motor vehicles, bicycles, bullock carts or any type of vehicle to the sacred area. (Eastern part of Manik Ganga) without a permit issued by any authorized officer or me.

04.2 No person shall park any vehicle within the camp area except at place received for the purpose.

05. *Barber Saloon :*

No person shall establish any barber saloon within the camp area except at the place which I have permitted.

06. *Kavadi Kada :*

No person shall establish any Kavadi Kada without permit issued by any authorized officer or me.

07. *Selling :*

07.1 The hawker are not allowed sell any thing within the sacred area, pilgrims rest area, bus stand and approach to Foot Bridges No. 01 and 02.

07.2 No person sell Thinooru, Ice-cream, Pooja watt, Pooja Bhanda, Food Commodities etc., within the camp area except at the place which I have permitted for the purpose.

07.3 No person shall establish or maintain within the sacred city, any sale, except selling of the flower shed at the flower already constructed on either sides of road leading to Kataragama.

07.4 Every building and every boutique should be provided with a dustbin and all refuse should be deposited therein.

07.5 All foods exposed for sale should be kept in properly constructed fly-proof cages.

WHEREAS Foot and Mouth disease has broken out among cattle, goats and pigs in Ja-Ela, Wattala and Kelaniya Divisional Secretary Divisions at Gampaha District of the Western Province, I, Sri Kamal Ranjith Amarasekara, Director General, Animal Production & Health by virtue of the powers vested on me under the Animal Disease Act, No. 59 of 1992, Regulation No. 5(1) do hereby declare the area having the following boundaries as 'Infected area'

North : Southern and borders of Negombo and Katana Divisional Secretary Divisions ;

East : Western borders of Gampaha, Mahara and Biyagama Divisional Secretary Divisions ;

South : Northern border of Panadura Divisional Secretary Division;

West : Indian Ocean.

Under Regulation No. 5(3) of the same Act, I proclaim that no movement of cattle, buffaloes, goats, pigs or cart traffic from and to this area shall be allowed, until this proclamation is revoked.

The attention of all cattle/buffalo owners and carters in this area is drawn to the Animal Diseases Act, No. 59 of 1992 which lay down the actions which persons are by law required to take in an "Infected Area". Details of these regulations can be obtained from the Government Veterinary Surgeons at Welisara and Kadawatha or the Divisional Secretaries at Ja-Ela, Welisara and Kelaniya Divisional Secretary Divisions.

This declaration shall take effect from the date hereof.
