AUDITOR GENERAL'S DEPARTMENT

Post of Deputy Auditor General Sri Lanka Audit Service Class I Grade I

APPLICATIONS are invited for the above post in the Auditor General's Department. Applications prepared as per specimen form appended to this notification should be addressed to the Auditor General, Auditor General's Department, Independence Square, Colombo 07 and should be sent under registered post to reach him on or before the following dates.

- (a) Local Applications : 17 December 2004
(b) Overseas Applications : 31 December 2004

The top - left hand corner of the envelope should be clearly marked "Post of Deputy Auditor General".

- Note - (i)* No complaints that an application form has been lost or delayed in the post will be considered. Applicants who delay their applications until the last date will do so at their own risk.
- (ii)* Overseas applicants may forward the application within the prescribed time, if they so desire to the office of the Sri Lanka Representative abroad assigned to or nearest to the country of their residence for transmission to the Auditor General.
- (iii)* Medical Examination and Passage - If a Sri Lankan applicant is selected from abroad for appointment under the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka he will be required to present himself for examination by an approved medical practitioner with a view to ascertaining whether he is physically fit for service. The fee for such examination as well as the cost of his passage to Sri Lanka shall be paid by the applicant.

2. Terms of Employment and Conditions of Service -

- (i) This post is permanent and is entitled to contributed Pension under the Contributed Pension Fund.
- (ii) If the applicant is holding a permanent and pensionable post in the Public Service, the conditions attached to the present post will be applicable in relation to the pension.

3. *Salary Scale* - The consolidated salary scale attached to the post is, Rs.215,520 - 8 x 9,000 - 287,520

Note - The selected candidate may be placed at an appropriate point on the above salary scale in consultation with the Director General of Establishments depending on his qualifications and experience

4. *Method of Recruitment* - An applicant possessing the following qualifications recommended by a Committee consisting of three Public Officers, one of whom shall be the Auditor General, will be appointed by the Public Service Commission.

The other two members of the Committee will be appointed by the Public Service Commission on the recommendation of the Auditor General.

5. *Qualifications Required* - Every applicant should furnish satisfactory proof that he/she-

- (a) Is a Sri Lankan,
(b) Is of excellent moral character and physically sound ;
(c) (i) Should at least be an Associate Member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka or England and Wales or the Chartered Institute of Management Accountants of the United Kingdom or the Chartered Association of Certified Accountants of the United Kingdom or similar professional body.

- (ii) Possesses 8 years post qualification experience.

However,

- (i) The period of post qualification experience will be reduced to 4 years in the case of applicants possessing 8 years experience in the staff grade in the Public Service/Provincial Public Service/Corporation Service.
- (ii) The post qualification experience will not be required in the case of applicants from the Sri Lanka Audit Service, possessing 8 years service in the Sri Lanka Audit Service of the Auditor General's Department.

(In arriving at the period of service for this purpose, study leave with full - pay, half - pay and no pay will not be taken into account).

- (d) Should not be more than 45 years of age on 17 December 2004. (This age limit does not apply to candidates already holding appointments in the Public Service/Provincial Public Service/Corporation Service).

6. Applicants will be required to produce any or all of the following documents when called upon to do so :

- (a) Certificate of Birth , (N. B.- Baptismal Certificate or Certificate of Birth issued for the purpose of the Code of Regulations for Assisted Schools will not be accepted);
(b) Certificate of Educational, Professional and other - qualifications ;
(c) Certificate in regard to post professional qualification experience.
(d) Two recent character certificates.
(This is not applicable to applicants already in the Public Service/Provincial Public Service/Corporation Service)
(e) Certificate of highest examinations passed in Sinhala, Tamil and English.

Note - (i) Documents or copies of documents should not be attached to the applications.

(ii) Applications of applicants who fail to produce documents when called upon to do so will not be considered.

7. Application from officers in the Public Service/Provincial Public Service/ Corporation Service should be forwarded to me through the respective Heads of Institutions and not personally to any officer in this office.
8. The General Conditions applicable to appointments to posts in the Public Service published at the beginning of part I : Section (11A) of this *Gazette* will be applicables to the recruitment to this post.
9. The receipt of applications will be notified to the candidates within three weeks from the closing date. If an acknowledgement is not received it should immediately be notified to me.

SINCE there are no institutions in Sri Lanka for the Homoeopathic Medicine System, this Ministry has explored the avenues of obtaining admissions from foreign institutions for Sri Lankan students interested to study the Homoeopathic Medicine System.

Accordingly a Homoeopathic Medical College in Lahore Pakistan has consented to grant admissions to Sri Lankan students.

In this regard it is hereby notified that those who are interested in following a 4 1/2 year Diploma Course in Homoeopathic Medicine having the under mentioned qualifications are requested to forward their applications.

Qualifications :

1. Should be over 18 years of Age.
2. Should have passed the G. C. E. (A/L) examination with 3 subjects in the Science curriculum with the subject of Chemistry, Physics and Bio Science.

3. Should have passed 6 subjects inclusive of Science subject in the G. C. E. (O/L) examination in one sitting and have obtained a Credit pass in Maths and English subjects.
4. Should be in a position spend a minimum of Rs. 5000 per month on self finance basis for the entire period of the course. (The Government or the Ministry will not provide any financial assistance)
