RECRUITMENT OF THE SRI LANKA AYURVEDIC SERVICE

Post of Preliminary Grade Medical Officers

APPLICATIONS are invited from citizens of Sri Lanka for the post of Preliminary Grade Medical Officer, in the category of Medical Officers, in the Department of Ayurveda. Candidates who have sent applications in terms of the advertisement appearing in the *Gazette* dated 04.07.2003 need not apply again. The applications prepared on a sheet of paper of size 13" x 8" according to the specimen form appearing herein under, should be sent under registered cover addressed to the " Commissioner of Ayurveda, Department of Ayurveda, Nawinna, Maharagama " on or before 14.06.2004. The words " Posts in the Sri Lanka Ayurveda Medical Service " should be written on the left-hand top corner of the envelope enclosing applications.

01. Salary Scale :

- (i) *For Graduates.*—Rs. 108,300—1 x 2,700—Rs. 111,000.
- (ii) *For Diploma Holders.*—A fixed annual salary of Rs. 105,600 will be paid within the first three years.

02. *Age Limit.*—Should be not less than 18 years of age and not more than 45 years of age as at 14.05.2004.

03. Educational and Other Qualifications :

- (a) Should be a citizen of Sri Lanka ; and
- (b) Should possess a Degree in Ayurveda / Siddha / Unani systems of medicine obtained after a five year course of study in a recognized university. Completed one year internship and registered as a Physician in the Medical Council of Ayurveda ; or
- (c) Possess a Diploma Certificate in Ayurveda / Siddha / Unani systems of medicine obtained after a five year course of study in a recognized Ayurvedic College and registered as a Physician in the Medical Council of Ayurveda ;
- (d) Should be of excellent character and physically fit and possess a very good eye sight.

Note.—When the waiting list does not contain an adequate number of graduate physicians in Ayurveda, Siddha or Unani for filling vacancies in the approved cadre, such vacancies should be filled by recruiting diploma holders in Ayurveda, Siddha or Unani with necessary qualifications.

04. *Conditions of Service.*—This post is permanent and pensionable. The selected candidate should contribute to the Widows' and Orphans' / Widowers' and Orphans' Pension Scheme. The appointment is subjected to a period of three years probation.

05. *Promotion.*—After recruitment to the posts of the Preliminary Grade, promotions are made in conformity with the terms and conditions of service laid down in the Sri Lanka Ayurveda Medical Service Minute.

Note.—(i) After the earliest batch of the Indigenous Physicians who have passed the Final (Degree / Diploma) Examination in (Ayurveda / Siddha / Unani) and who have fulfilled all the qualifications laid down in the scheme of recruitment as at 14.05.2004 but so far not recruited to the Government Service, but has been recruited in the order of merit based on the individual marks secured by each of them and after having been recruited to fill the vacancies of the existing course, the other batches of the Ayurveda / Siddha / Unani Graduate Medical Officers will be recruited, based on merit as aforesaid according in the chronological order they have passed their examinations.

(ii) From among the Ayurvedic Medical Officers possessing the Diploma Certificate, selection will be made to fill the vacancies based on the order of priority indicated in the Register or Registration as an Ayurvedic Medical Officer.

(iii) Provided however, where the Cabinet takes another decision which runs counter to the above-mentioned scheme of recruitment and the above determination, (Methodology) such decision made by the Cabinet shall supersede the above-mentioned scheme of recruitment and the determination aforesaid.

(iv) 75% of the vacancies existing in the approved cadre will be filled by Ayurvedic Medical Officers possessing a degree in Ayurveda / Siddha / Unani system of medicine and the balance 25% from those who possess a Diploma in the Ayurveda / Siddha / Unani system of medicine.

(v) The criteria adduced for the recruitment of Siddha / Unani Physicians within the total approved cadre gazetted in the paragraph (i) of the Part (I) of the *Gazette of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka* dated 23.08.2002 reading along with section substituted as 10.10 of the minute of the Sri Lanka Ayurvedic Service published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 924/2 dated 20th May, 1996 of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, will apply for recruitment to the number of vacancies available in the cadre.

06. Candidates will be selected through an interview and after verification of qualifications conducted by an Interview Board constituted for this purpose.

07. Selected applicants should be prepared to serve in any part of the Island.

08. The selected applicants should be prepare to produce any one or all the following documents when called for :—

- (i) Certificate of Birth ;
- (ii) Degree or Diploma certificate ;
- (iii) Certificate of experience ;
- (iv) Certificate of Registration in the Medical Council of Ayurveda ;
- (v) Grama Niladhari's certificate counter-signed by the Divisional Secretary.

09. The applications of officers in the public Service should be channeled only through the respective Heads of Departments. Applications received after 14.06.2004 will be rejected. The applications and all relevant documents should be addressed to the official designation of the Commissioner of Ayurveda and not to the personal name of any other officer.

10. Reference is also requested to the General Conditions applicable to the Appointments in the Public Service appearing in the beginning of Part I ; Section (IIA) of the *Gazette of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka*.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS REGULATORY COMMISSION OF SRI LANKA (TRCSL)

Examination for the issue of Amateur Radio Operator's License by the Telecommunications Regulatory Commission of Sri Lanka

CATEGORIES of Amateur Radio Operator's Licenses :

- (a) Amateur Radio Operator's Advance Class License ;
- (b) Amateur Radio Operator's General Class License ;
- (c) Amateur Radio Operator's Novice Class "A" License ;
- (d) Amateur Radio Operator's Novice Class "B" License.

2. *Minimum entry Requirements.*— Every candidate entering for the examination must be fourteen (14) years of age or over on the closing date of applications.

3. *Scheme of Examination.*— (a) *Advance Class* - The examination consists of 2 parts -

Part 1.— Two (2) compulsory written papers to be undertaken at one sitting :

Paper I.— Advanced Electrical Technology and Radio Communications (3 hours) ;

Paper II.— Licensing conditions, operating practices and procedures (2 hours) ;

Part 2.— Practical Morse Code Test (20 words per minute).

(b) *General Class.*— The Examination consists of 2 parts.

Part 1.— Two (2) compulsory written papers to be undertaken at one sitting :

Paper I.— Fundamentals of Electricity and Radio Communications (2 hours).

Paper II.— Licensing conditions operating practices and procedures (1 hour).

Part 2.— Practical Morse Code Test (12 words per minute).

(c) *Novice Class "A".*— The Examination consists of 2 parts :

Part 1.— Two (2) compulsory written paper to be undertaken at one sitting ;

Paper I.— Basic Electricity, Radio and Electronic theory (2 hours);
Paper II.— Licensing conditions, Operating practices and procedures (1 hour).

Part 2.— Practical Morse Code Test (5 words per minute).

(d) *Novice Class "B".*— The Examination consists of two (2) compulsory written papers to be undertaken at one sitting ;

Paper I.— Basic electricity, Radio and Electronic Theory (2 hours);

Paper II.— Licensing conditions, operating practices and procedures (1 hour).

Morse Code Test is not required for a Novice Class "B" License.

4. *Conditions of Examination.*— The following conditions shall apply to all categories of Amateur Radio License Examination :-

- (i) To pass the Examination, the candidates should pass all parts of the examination ;
- (ii) Candidates must pass the Part I of the Examination (2 written papers) at the same sitting ;
- (iii) Only those candidates who pass Part I of the Examination will be allowed to appear for Part II (Morse Test) ;
- (iv) Candidates who obtain a pass in Part I, may apply only for Part II (Morse Test) at any successive examination.

5. *Medium of Examination.*— The examination will be conducted in English Medium only.

6. *Examination Fees.*— Applicants who conform to the requirements of the examination are required to remit the Examination Fees mentioned in this notification to the 'Telecommunications Regulatory Commission of Sri Lanka'. If further information in this regard is required the applicants are requested to write to the Telecommunications Regulatory Commission of Sri Lanka.

The Examination fee is payable either by a Money Order or a Pay Order/Draft from any Bank drawn in the name of the "Telecommunications Regulatory Commission of Sri Lanka". The entry form must be sent by recorded delivery on registered post or delivered by hand. Official receipts must be retained as the Telecommunications Regulatory Commission of Sri Lanka will not consider any claim that a form has been overlooked or lost unless proof of posting of delivery is produced.

Fees are not refundable or cannot be transferred from one examination to another at a later date. Any candidate who withdraws his application or cannot appear for the examination due to any reason whatsoever will be required to pay approximate examination fee for any subsequently entry.
