PUBLIC SERVICE MUTUAL PROVIDENT ASSOCIATION ORDINANCE

RULES made by the Public Service Mutual Provident Association, under Section 16 of the Public Service Mutual Provident Association Ordinance (Chapter 283) and approved by the Minister in charge of the subject of Finance.

Rules

The rules published in *Gazette* No. 5147 dated 17th June, 1892 as last amended by *Gazette* No. 1249 dated 9th August, 2002 are hereby further amended as follows :-

(1) Under the heading "Chapter 1 - General Rules"

(a) by the substitution for the proviso in rule 2 (iii) of the following :

"Provided however where the Head of his Department certifies that on joining the Government Service or Provincial Government service he has undergone a Medical Examination and found fit for service he shall be exempted from the Medical Examination referred to above"

- (b) by the substitution in rule 4, for the words “or 10 percentum” of the words “10 percentum or in higher multiples of 2 1/2 percentum”
- (c) by the substitution in rule 13A for the words “advance of Rs. 5,000 which is payable once for the entire period of membership and recoverable in 50 monthly installments” of the words “advance of Rs. 7,500 recoverable in 50 monthly installments and the amount outstanding under this rule shall not at any time exceed Rs. 7,500”
- (d) by the substitution in rule 13C for the words “a festival loan of Rs. 2,000” of the words “a festival loan of Rs. 3,000”
- (e) rule 14(2) is hereby rescinded and the following rule substituted therefore :

“14(2) It shall be lawful for the President or a nominated member of the Committee of Management deputed by him at his discretion to grant at the death of the spouse of any member or in the event of the member being unmarried at the death of the mother or father of such member, who has completed 25 years of membership, a loan not exceeding Rupees Ten Thousand (Rs. 10,000) once in a lifetime only, for which no interest shall become payable from the Death Donation Fund at his death in terms of Rule 10 and such loan shall be recoverable from the death donation payable in respect of the member from the Death Donation Fund. The application for payment of such loan shall be made within a period of three months from the date of death of spouse or mother or father as the case may be”

- (f) by the substitution in rule 15(ii) for the words “in the month of March” of the words “in the month of April”
- (g) rule 19 is hereby rescinded and the following rule substituted therefore :-

“19 The percentage of the interest as decided by the Committee of Management from the profit accruing to the funds of the Association shall be credited annually to the account of the member in the books of the Association in proportion to the amount standing to their credit at the close of the financial year in respect of such interest declared. The amounts lying in the member’s dividend account also shall be transferred to the interest Account,

and such interest shall be refunded when he withdraws his contribution or ceases to be a member in the Association as the case may be. The interest so accumulated shall not be considered when computing loans under rule 12.

Provided however, a member may at the time of his retirement at his request, withdraw the amounts lying to his credit in the Interest Accounts on that date subject to the approval of the Committee of Management and continue to be a member ;

- (h) by the substitution in rule 19(i) for the words “and the Committee of Management shall have the power to appropriate the interest accrued thereon to pay the rent for the office building” of the words “the interest accrued thereon shall be credited to the Building Fund ;

2. Under the heading “Chapter II - Rules for the Investment of the Surplus funds of the Public Service Mutual Provident Association in House Property Loan”

- (a) in rule 12 by the repeal of paragraph (i) of the rule, and the substitution therefore, of the following paragraph ;
- (b) “12 (i) The house property loan shall be limited to Rupees Two Hundred Thousand (Rs. 200,000) In the event both the applicant and spouse being employed in the Public Service Mutual Provident Association they be collectively entitled to obtain a loan of Rupees Two Hundred Thousand (Rs. 200,000) only”

3. Under the heading “Chapter III-Rules for the establishment of Scholarship Fund of the Public Service Mutual Provident Association :

- (a) In rule 1 by the substitution ;
 - (i) for the words “in and after the fifth year Rs. 150,000 of the words “from 5th year to the 7th year Rs. 150,000”
 - (ii) by the addition immediately after paragraph (e) of the following :

“I(f) in and after the eighth year Rs. 225,000”
 - (iii) by the substitution in rule 2 for the words “Rs. 500 per month” of the words “Rs. 750.00 per month”

IT is hereby notified for the information of the general public and occupiers of Factories coming within the purview of the Factories Ordinance, No. 45 of 1942, as amended by Factories (Amendment) Act, No. 54 of 1961, Factories (Amendment) Law, No. 12 of 1976 and Factories (Amendment) Act, No. 18 of 1998, Factories (Amendment) Act, No. 33 of 2000 and Factories (Amendment) Act, No. 19 of 2002 that the following Officers are now in operation.

Occupiers of Factories in the Electoral and Administrative Districts enumerated in Column III of the Schedule below should henceforth furnish all returns, reports, notices and other documents required to be furnished from time to time by the aforesaid Ordinance and the Regulations framed thereunder to the official address of the District Factory Inspecting Engineer mentioned in Column II thereof.

Attention is drawn to the requirement under Section 90 (1) (b) of the Factories Ordinance, wherein it is mandatory to display these addresses at the principal entrances of a factory at which employed persons enter.
