CALLING FOR APPLICATIONS FOR TRAINING OF MIDWIVES UNDER THE MINISTRY OF HEALTHCARE, NUTRITION AND UVA WELLASA DEVELOPMENT

IN terms of Cabinet Decision arrived at the Meeting held on 21.01.2004, applications are invited from qualified unmarried female citizens of Sri Lanka for recruitment as trainee to the above training Course. The selection will be made on the aggregate marks of the G. C. E. (Advanced Level) Examination.

01. Educational Qualifications :

- (i) Passed G. C. E. (Advanced Level) Examination in any three subjects in the years 2000 or 2001,

and

- (ii) Passed G. C. E. (Ordinary Level) Examination in six subjects including English Language at not more than two sittings with Credit Passes for Sinhala/Tamil Language or Sinhala/Tamil Literature, Mathematics, Science and another subject.

02. Other Qualifications :

- (i) Should be not less than 18 and not more than 30 years of age on 01.06.2004.
- (ii) Should be of sound physique.
- (iii) Should be over 04 feet 10 inches (145 c.m.) in height.
- (iv) Should be unmarried. Should not marry during the period of training. The trainees who are employed temporarily after theoretical training too should not marry until such time they are given appointments after attachment to the formal training.
- (v) Should be bound to serve in any station where vacancies exist within the relevant Provincial Council from which recruitment is made.
- (vi) A certified copy of the voters list should be attached to the application to prove the residence for 03 years within the district from which the candidate forward her application. If the name of the candidate is not available in the Voters List the names of her parents should be available in the Voters List and in such an instance the certified copy of the Certificate of Birth should be attached to the application to prove the names of her parents.

03. The Candidates who have fulfilled the above qualifications will be called for an interview based on the marks secured by them at the G. C. E. (A/L) Examination and also taking into consideration the number of vacancies exist within the relevant provincial council.

04. The number of vacancies exist within such of the Provincial Councils are given below and the recruitment will be made based on the vacancies so exist.

The trainee who reside within the relevant Provincial Council should refer the application to the relevant Deputy Provincial Director of Health Services Candidates can obtain more details from the Deputy Provincial Director of Health Services of their Province.

(IV) The training of trainees who are unsuccessful at the prescribed examinations whose work and conduct are found to the unsatisfactory or who fail to comply with the conditions of leave and examinations of the School of Training to which they are assigned during the period of training is liable to be discontinued without payment of any compensation.

05. *Method of Application.*—Applications should be prepared on a paper of 21x29 c.m. in size using both sides as per form of specimen appended to this letter.

06. Applications should be referred to the relevant Deputy Provincial Director of Health Services before 19.06.2004. The Address of the relevant Deputy Provincial Directors of Health Services is given in the para 04 where vacancies are indicated.

07. A copy of the Mark Sheet of the G. C. E. (A/L) Examination should be attached to the Application.

(V) Candidates on admission to the School of Training should sign an agreement with the Director General of Health Services, that they would complete the training successfully and they serve the Department of Health Services for a minimum of (05) five years period if they were given appointments after training. If Candidates happened to withdraw from the training during the period of training they should refund the allowances paid to them during the period of training and the other expenses incurred by the Government, to the Department. If they fail to do so, action will be taken to recovery that amount in accordance with the agreement.

08. (I) *Scheme of training.*—Recruitments will be made at district level depending on the number of vacancies available in the relevant district by an interview subject to the marks secured at the G. C. E. (A/L) Examination. The first batch as selected above will be undergoing training for a period of 1 1/2 years. An allowance of Rs. 45,180 per annum will be paid to the first batch during the period of their 1 1/2 years training.

09. *Terms of Engagement in Service.*—The trainees who complete the training successfully will be given permanent appointments with entitlement, to the contributory Pension Schemes in the Class II Segment 'B' of the Midwives Service.

The Salary Scale applicable to the Post is Rs. 104,520-7x1800-5x2880-131,520 P.A.

The second batch will be attached to the field training activities as Assistant Midwives after a basic theoretical training of 03 months. At the end of the said training they will be attached to the training as Assistants to the Midwives in the divisions where vacancies exist in the relevant Districts. Subsequently they will be attached to serve temporarily as Assistant Midwives in the fields where vacancies exist. The second batch so recruited will be paid an allowance of Rs. 3000 per month. They will be recruited later for training as Midwives depending on the accommodations available in training institutions and thereafter they will be appointed to the vacancies available in the Post of Midwives However the period of 03 months referred to above and the period of service in the field and the period of service as an Assistant Midwife will not be under any circumstance be added to the period of training of service when appointed as Midwives.

10. *Penalties for false information :* Candidates should enter educations and other qualifications correctly and very carefully when filling their Applications. Provided the information furnished by then were found to be false after appointment, action will be taken to dismiss them from the service after canceling their appointments and also to black list the names of such Candidates.

11. *Medical Examination.*—Candidates selected are required to undergo a Medical Examination as to their physical fitness to follow the relevant Training Course and to serve in any part of the Island. Candidates who are found to be unfit at the Medical Examination will be disqualified from following the relevant Training Course.
