Admission to National Colleges of Education to follow a Pre-service Professional Course in Teacher Education – 2005

APPLICATIONS are called from those with requisite academic qualifications and eligibility to follow a three year Pre-service Professional Course in Teacher Education in National Colleges of Education.

2.0 Eligibility :

A candidate should,

- 2.1 be a citizen of Sri Lanka ;
- 2.2 be of excellent character and sound physical and mental health ;

2.3 Age :

- 2.3.1 not be more than 25 years of age on 01.01.2005
- 2.3.2 not be more than 30 years of age on 01.01.2005
for the catholic/christian Clergy only.
- 2.3.3 not be more than 27 years of age on 01.01.2005 for the Buddhist Monks those who apply for Buddhism course.

2.4 be unmarried.

3.0 Basic Educational Qualifications :

- 3.1 Passed three subjects in one sitting at G.C.E.(A/L) Examination (two passes in one sitting for Sri Pada National College of Education) held in 2003.

Applicants for technological studies course should refer the note in 4.14 and an applicants from clergy for catholicism/Christianity course should refer the note in 4.10)

- 3.2 Passed G.C.E. (O/L) Examination/Primary Pirivena Final Examination including Mathematics and Sinhala/Tamil Language in six subjects, in not more than two sittings. (Five subjects should have been passed in the first sitting).

- 3.3 If the special requirements at the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination mentioned under 3.2 are not completed in two sittings, they should have been completed in the third sitting. All the Qualifications should have been completed on or before the closing date of applications.

- 3.4 Those who apply for English Medium courses should have a credit pass in English Language/English Literature at G.C.E.(O/L) Examination.

4.0 Educational Qualifications and other Special requirements :

Educational Qualifications and special requirements (if any) applicable to courses in National Colleges of Education are as follows :

4.1 Course No. 01 - Primary Education :

- 4.1.1 Three passes including Sinhala/Tamil Language in one sitting at G.C.E.(A/L) Examination held in 2003 (two passes in one sitting for Sri Pada National College of Education), and

- 4.1.2 Passed G.C.E.(O/L) Examination in six subjects with Sinhala/Tamil Language and Mathematics.

4.2 Course No. 02 - Science :

- 4.2.1 Three passes in any of the following subjects, Botany, Zoology, Physics, Chemistry & Biology in one sitting at G.C.E. (A/L) Examination held in 2003 (two passes in one sitting for Sri Pada National College of Education), and

- 4.2.2 Passed G.C.E. (O/L) Examination in six subjects with a pass in Sinhala/Tamil Language and a Credit pass in Mathematics 32 or in Mathematics 42.

4.3 Course No. 02 - Mathematics :

- 4.3.1 Three passes in any of the following subjects ; Applied Mathematics, Pure Mathematics, Mathematics, Combined Mathematics, Higher Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, in one sitting at G.C.E. (A/L) Examination held in 2003 (Two passes in one sitting in Sri Pada NCOE), and

4.3.2 Passed G.C.E. (O/L) Examination in six subjects with a pass in Sinhala/Tamil Language and a Credit pass in Mathematics 32 or Mathematics 42.

4.4 *Course No. 04 - Physical Education :*

4.4.1 Passed any three subjects in one sitting at G.C.E. (A/L) Examination held in 2003, and

4.4.2 Passed G.C.E.(O/L) Examination in six subjects with passes in Sinhala/Tamil Language and Mathematics, and

4.4.3 Competency in organized and recognized sports.

75 marks will be awarded in maximum for 3 different sports/events/activities in a priority order as listed below.

Note :- (i) *Recognized Sports Competitions (International) :-* Competitions represented by Sri Lanka National Sports teams or School Sports teams registered through National Sports Associations of the Ministry of Education/Ministry of Sports.

(ii) *Recognized Sports competitions :-* National level competitions organized by the Ministry of Education/Ministry of Sports/National Youth Services Council.

Provincial level competitions organized by the Provincial Ministry of Education/Provincial Ministry of Sports/National Youth Services Council.

District level competitions organized by the Provincial Ministry of Sports/National Youth Services Council.

Zonal level competitions organized by the Provincial Ministry of Education.

(iii) 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in "A grade" competitions organized by Sports Associations registered under the Ministry of Sports and Ministry of Education only will be given priority in order.

(iv) Sports competencies should have been achieved within the preceeding 5 years before the closing date of applications.

- (v) Marks will be awarded to only one certificate for the same event in the same age group in same year out of three sports certificates.)

4.5 *Course No. 05 - Food Technology :*

4.5.1 Three passes including Home Economics in one sitting at G.C.E.(A/L) Examination held in 2003, and

4.5.2 Passed G.C.E.(O/L) Examination in six subjects with Sinhala/Tamil Language, Mathematics and Science.

4.6 *Course No. 06 - English :*

4.6.1 Three passes in one sitting including English (Not General English) at G.C.E. (A/L) Examination held in 2003 and Passed G.C.E. (O/L) Examination/London G.C.E. (O/L) Examination in 06 subjects with a credit pass in English Language/English Literature and passed in Sinhala/Tamil Language and Mathematics ; or

4.6.2 Passed any three subjects in one sitting at G.C.E. (A/L) Examination held in 2003 and three passes in one sitting including English at London G.C.E. (A/L) Examination held in 2003 and passed G.C.E. (O/L) Examination/London G.C.E. (O/L) in 06 subjects with a credit pass in English Language/English Literature and passed Sinhala/Tamil Language and Mathematics; or

4.6.3 Passed any three subjects in one sitting at G.C.E. (A/L) Examination held in 2003 and passed G.C.E. (O/L) Examination/London (O/L) Examination in 06 subjects with a distinction/credit pass in English Language/English Literature and passes in Sinhala/Tamil Language and Mathematics.

Note : (i) In selection priority will be given to those who qualify under 4.6.1 and 4.6.2 they need not to sit for the Proficiency Test. Qualifications should be proved at the interview.

(ii) Those who qualify under 4.6.3 should sit for a proficiency test.

4.7 *Course No. 07 - Buddhism :*

Buddhist monks and the laity both can apply for the Buddhism Course. All the requirements should be completed in 2003 or before.

4.7.1 Three passes in one sitting including two of the following subjects. Buddhism, Buddhist Civilization, Pali and Sinhala at G.C.E.(A/L) Examination held in 2003 and passed Daham School Final Examination.

4.7.2 passed Pracheena Preliminary Examination.

4.7.3 Passed Bauddha Dharmacharya Examination.

4.7.4 Passed G.C.E.(O/L) Examination in six subjects with Sinhala, Buddhism and Mathematics/passed Preliminary Pirivena final examination in six subjects with Sinhala, Mathematics and Thripitaka Dharmaya.

Note : (i) In selection priority will be given to the following order :

- (a) Candidates those who have all the certificates including 4.7.1, 4.7.4
- (b) Candidates those who have certificates under 4.7.1, 4.7.2, 4.7.4
- (c) Candidates those who have certificates under 4.7.1, 4.7.3, 4.7.4
- (d) Candidates those who have certificates under 4.7.1, 4.7.4)

4.8 *Course No. 08 - Hinduism :*

4.8.1 Three passes including two of the following subjects Hinduism, Hindu Civilization, Sanskrit and Tamil in one sitting at G.C.E. (A/L) Examination held in 2003.

4.8.2 Shaiva Siddhantha Pandithar Certificate.

4.8.3 Shaiva Pulaver Certificate.

4.8.4 Ilang Shaiva Pulaver Certificate.

4.8.5 Passed G.C.E. (O/L) Examination in six subjects including Tamil Language, Mathematics and Hinduism.

Note.- In selection, priority will be given in the following order :

- (a) Candidates those who have all the other certificates and 4.8.1, 4.8.5
- (b) Candidates those who have two certificates out of other three certificates and 4.8.1, 4.8.5
- (c) Candidates those who have one certificate out of other three certificates and 4.8.1, 4.8.5
- (d) Candidates those who have certificates under 4.8.1, 4.8.5.

(All the requirements mentioned above should have been completed in 2003 or before.)

4.9 *Course No. 09 - Islam :*

- 4.9.1 Three passes including one of the following subjects Islam, Islamic Civilization and Arabic in one sitting at G.C.E. (A/L) Examination held in 2003.
- 4.9.2 Passed AL-Alim Examination (Both Part 1 and Part 2)
- 4.9.3 Moulavi Certificate.
- 4.9.4 Passed G.C.E.(O/L) Examination in six subjects with Tamil Language, Mathematics and Islam.

(Note.- Priority order in selection.

- (a) Candidates those who have all the other certificates and 4.9.1, 4.9.4.
- (b) Candidates those who have one certificate out of other certificates and 4.9.1, 4.9.4.
- (c) Candidates those who have certificates under 4.9.1, 4.9.4.

All the requirements mentioned above should have been completed in 2003 or before.)

4.10 *Course No. 10 - Catholicism/Christianity :*

- 4.10.1 Three passes in one sitting at G.C.E. (A/L) Examination held in 2003 and followed the course in Theology (BTH), or
- 4.10.2 Three passes including Christianity in one sitting at G.C.E.(A/L) Examination held in 2003 and a pass in Teachers' Certificate of Catholicism conducted by the National Cathetical Centre, or
- 4.10.3 Three passes in one sitting at G.C.E.(A/L) Examination held in 2003 and the Diploma Certificate in Catholicism conducted by Deva Dharma Nikethanaya, or
- 4.10.4 Three passes in one sitting at G.C.E.(A/L) Examination held in 2003 Teachers' Certificate in Catholicism conducted by the Catholic Bishop's Diocision Level, or
- 4.10.5 Three passes in one sitting at G.C.E.(A/L) Examination held in 2003 and Dharmavedi Diploma Certificate conducted by the Lanka Theological College at Pilimatalawa, or
- 4.10.6 Three passes in one sitting at G.C.E.(A/L) Examination held in 2003 and National Certificate (Dharmacharya) on Religious knowledge conducted by the National Christian Council, and
- 4.10.7 Passed G.C.E.(O/L) Examination in six subjects with passes for Sinhala/Tamil Language, Mathematics and a credit pass in Christianity/Christianity (R.C.)

(Note : (i) In selection, 85% of the total number of admissions will be called for the interview from Catholic applicants who qualify under 4.10.1, 4.10.2, 4.10.3, 4.10.4 according to the priority order.

(ii) In selection, 15% of the total number of admissions will be called for the Interview from Christian applicants who qualify under 4.10.5, 4.10.6 according to the priority order.

(iii) 40% of the admissions will be from the Catholic/Christian Clergy. If qualified applicants are not available from clergy, pass (A/L) in 2003, candidates will be selected from clergy passed (A/L) in the preceeding years from 2003. If there will not be 40% of candidates from the clergy the remaining vacancies will be filled from the laity.

(iv) Indicate whether the religion is Catholicism/Christianity in the space allocated in the application form).

4.11 *Course No. 11 - Library Science & Information Technology :*

- 4.11.1 Three passes in one sitting at G.C.E. (A/L) Examination held in 2003, and
- 4.11.2 Passed G.C.E. (O/L) Examination in six subjects including Sinhala/Tamil Language, Mathematics and a Credit pass in English.

4.12 *Course No. 12 - Special Education :*

- 4.12.1 Passed any three subjects in one sitting at G.C.E. (A/L) Examination held in 2003, and
- 4.12.2 Passed G.C.E. (O/L) Examination in six subjects with Sinhala/Tamil Language and Mathematics.
