Grade II

Workers employed in stripping, clipping and bark cutting, Washing and re-smoking mouldy rubber, general labour including moving to presses, weighing machines and other parts of the store, Assembling, wrapping and pricking rubber for bailing, pressing, hooping and wire tying, cutting, jute hessian covers, painting, drying, assembling and marking, treating jute hessian for special packing, covering bales with jute hessian and stitching, laying out bales, cleaning and sweeping of stores and drains.

Intermediate Grade

Workers employed in weighing, grading and sorting, the work of press operators.

Grade I

Workers employed in loading, unloading and carrying bales, stacking.
