## PART I : SECTION (I) – GENERAL

### AMENDMENT TO THE MINUTE OF THE SRI LANKA ENGINEERING SERVICE

Since the term “ should have completed a period of 10 years service by Engineers in Class II Grade II for promotion to Class II Grade I ” indicated in Section 8 of the Minutes of the Sri Lanka Engineering Service published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* dated 07. 06. 1988 which was published in substitution to the Minute of the Sri Lanka Engineering Service dated 30th April 1984 published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 296/2 of 7th May 1984 of the *Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka* is incomplete, this section is amended in conformity with the general conditions in the Minutes of the All Island Service in the following manner.

“ The vacancies in Class II Grade I of the Sri Lanka Engineering Service will be filled by promotion of officers in Class II Grade II. An officer in Class II Grade II should have passed the First Efficiency Bar Examination, possess full professional qualifications and have been confirmed in a permanent post indicated in the schedule possessing following qualifications together with a minimum of 10 years period of service to be eligible for promotion to Class II Grade I. The substantive period of service as an Engineer completed in a post indicated in the schedule under temporary basis will be reckoned to be qualified.

- (i) Having passed First and Second Efficiency Bar Examination on due dates.
- (ii) Having possessed full professional qualifications
- (iii) Having passed Second Language (oral)
- (iv) Having earned salary increments during the 5 years immediately prior to the due date for promotion
- (v) Not having been subjected to any punishment under any disciplinary inquiry during the 5 years prior to the due date of promotion.
