FILLING OF A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF A MEMBER OF THE RIDEEGAMA PRADESHIYA SABHA UNDER SECTION 65A (2) OF THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES ELECTIONS ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 262)

**FILLING OF A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF A MEMBER OF THE ALAWWA PRADESHIYA SABHA UNDER
SECTION 65A (2) OF THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES ELECTIONS ORDINANCE
(CHAPTER 262)**

WHEREAS the Office of a member in Alawwa Pradeshiya Sabha has fallen vacant by reason of failing to make and subscribe an oath or affirmation in terms of Seventh Schedule of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka ;
