NOTICE is hereby given in terms of Section 52 (2) of the Ceylon Electricity Board Act, No. 17 of 1969 that it is intended to introduce with effect from 01st November, 2004, the following tariffs and charges for the supply of electrical energy to all direct consumers of the Electricity Board who are supplied by the integrated hydro-thermal electrical power system.

**SECTION 1**

**DOMECTIC TARIFF**

**Rate D – 1**

- (a) This rate applies to supply of electricity used for Domestic purposes in private residences.
- (b) The charges in each 30 day billing period for supply udner this tariff will be s follows : –
- (i) For the 1st 30 units (1st block) at a basic rate of Rs. 3.00 per unit, and
  - (ii) For the units in excess of 30 units (2nd block) at a basic rate of Rs. 3.70, and
  - (iii) For the units in excess of 60 units up to 90 units (3rd block) at a basic rate of Rs. 4.10, and
  - (iv) For the units in excess of 90 units up to 180 units (4th block) at a baxic rate of Rs. 11.40, and
  - (v) For the units in excess of 1800 units (5th block) at a rate of Rs. 16.40.
- (c) A fixed charge of Rs. 30.0 per billing period will supply.

**Section 2**

**Tariff Applicable to Religious premises and charitable Instituitons**

**Rate R – 1**

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies of electricity to –
- (i) Places of public religious worship including private residences of priests where such residences are associated with or are within the curtilage of a place of public religious worship, and

- (ii) Homes for Aged, Orphanages, and Homes for the handicapped, which are specifically certified by the Director of Social Services as Charitable Institutions, and approved by the Ceylon Electricity Board.
- (b) The installation should not include any building used mainly or wholly for commercial purposes.
- (c) The charges in each 30 day billing period under this tariff will be as follows : -
  - (i) For the 1st 30 units (1st block) at a basic rate of Rs. 2.50 per unit, and
  - (ii) For the units in excess of 30 up to 90 units (2nd block) at a basic rate of Rs. 2.70, and
  - (iii) For the units in excess of 90 units up to 180 units (3rd block) at a basic rate of Rs. 4.50, and
  - (iv) For the units in excess of 180 units (4th block) at a basic rate of Rs. 8.00 per unit.
- (d) A fixed charge of Rs. 30.0 per billing period will apply.

### Section 3

Tariff applicable for Bulk Sales to Lanka Electricity Company (Pvt.) Ltd.

The rates L - 1 and L - 2 set out below shall apply to bulk supplies provided to Lanka Electricity Co. (Pvt.) Limited.

#### Rate L - 1

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies delivered and metered at 400/230 Volts Nominal. The charges in each billing period under this tariff shall be the sum of the charges (i) and (ii) given below : -
  - (i) A maximum demand charge at the rate of Rs. 240,00 per kVA of the maximum demand made during the billing period at each individual point of supply.
  - (ii) A basic rate of Rs. 7.40 per unit.

#### Rate L - 2

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies delivered and metered at 11,000 Volts nominal and above. The charges in each billing period under this tariff shall be the sum of the charges (i) and (ii) given below : -
  - (i) A maximum demand charge at the rate of Rs. 220,00 per kVA of the maximum demand made during the billing period at each individual point of supply.
  - (ii) A basic rate of Rs. 5.60 per unit.

### Section 4

#### General Purpose Tariff

The rates G.P. 1, G.P. 2 and G.P. 3 set out below shall be applicable to a supply of electricity to be used in shops, offices, banks, warehouses, public buildings, hospitals, educational establishments, places of entertainment and other premises not covered under any other tariffs in this schedule.

#### Rate G.P. - 1

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies at each individual point of supply delivered and metered at 400/230 Volts nominal and where the contract demand is less than 42kVA.
- (b) The charges in each billing period under this tariff shall be the sum of charges (i) and (ii) given below : -
  - (i) A basic rate of Rs. 11.40 per unit.
  - (ii) A fixed charge of Rs. 30.00 per billing period if contract demand is 10kVA and below and a fixed charge of Rs. 230.00 if the contract demand is above 10kVA but less than 42kVA.

#### Rate G.P. - 2

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies at each individual point of supply delivered and metered at 400/230 Volts nominal and where the contract demand is equal to or exceeds 42kVA.
- (b) The charges in each billing period for supplies under this tariff shall be the sum of charges (i), (ii) and (iii) given below : -

- (i) A maximum demand charge at the rate of Rs. 500.00 per kVA of the maximum demand made during the billing period,
- (ii) A unit charge at the basic rate of RS. 11.30 per unit ;
- (iii) A fixed charge of Rs. 800.00 per billing period.

Rate G.P. - 3

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies at each individual point of supply delivered and metered at 11,00 Volts nominal and above.
- (b) The charges in each billing period for supplies under this tariff shall be the sum of charges (i), (ii) and (iii) given below : -
  - (i) A maximum demand charge at the rate of Rs. 480.00 per kVA of the maximum demand made during the billing period,
  - (ii) A unit charge at the basic rate of RS. 11.20 per unit ;
  - (iii) A fixed charge of Rs. 800.00 per billing period.

Section 5

Industrial Tariff

The rate 1.1, 1.2 and 1.3 set out below shall be applicable to a supply of electricity used wholly or mainly for motive power or for electro-chemical process in factories, workshops, foundries, oil mills, spinning and weaving mills, water supply and irrigation pumping stations, port and dock installations but shall not be applicable to a supply of electricity covered under Section 6 of this schedule.

Rate I - 1

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies at each individual point of supply delivered and metered at 400/230 Volts nominal and where the contract demand is less than 42kVA.
- (b) The charges in each billing period for supplies under this tariff shall be the sum of charges (i) and (ii) given below : -
  - (i) A unit charge at the basic rate of Rs. 7.50 per unit.
  - (ii) A fixed charge of Rs. 30.00 per billing period if the contract demand is 10kVA or below and a fixed charge of Rs. 230.00 if the contract demand is above 10kVA but less than 42kVA.

Rate I - 2

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies at each individual point of supply delivered and metered at 400/230 Volts nominal and where the contract demand is equal to or exceed 42kVA.
- (b) The charges in each billing period for supplies under this tariff shall be the sum of charges (i), (ii) and (iii) given below : -
  - (i) A unit charge at the basic rate of Rs. 7.10 per unit.
  - (ii) A maximum demand charge at the rate of Rs. 400.00 per kVA of the maximum demand during a billing period.
  - (iii) A fixed charge of RS. 800.00 per billing period.

Rate I - 3

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies at each individual point of supply delivered and metered at 11,000 Volts nominal and above.
- (b) The charges in each billing period for supplies under this tariff shall be the sum of charges (i), (ii) and (iii) given below : -
  - (i) A unit charge at the basic rate of Rs. 7.00 per unit.
  - (ii) A maximum demand charge at the rate of Rs. 380.00 per kVA of the maximum demand during a billing period.
  - (iii) A fixed charge of RS. 800.00 per billing period.

Section 6

Industrial Time of Day Tariff

The rates I.1 (T.D), I. 2 (T.D) and I.3 set out below shall be applicable to a supply of electricity at each individual point of supply used wholly or mainly for motive power or for electro-chemical processes in factories, workshops, foundries, oil mills, spinning and weaving mills, water supply and irrigation pumping stations, port and dock installations and other similar industrial installations. These rates I.1 (T.D), I.2 (T.D) and I.3 (T.D) are applicable to a supply of electricity for Industrial Consumers where Ceylon Electricity Board and the consumer mutually agree to one of these optional rates in lieu of the corresponding rates I.1, I.2 and I.3 described in the section 5 of this notice. The General Manager, Ceylon Electricity Board shall take into consideration the time taken for procurement of suitable metering equipment and other factors, determine at his discretion the date from which the relevant rate shall become effective in respect of each supply on the case by case basis.

Rate I-1 (T.D)

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies at each individual point of supply delivered and metered at 400/230 Volts nominal and where the contract demand is less than 42kVA.
- (b) The charges in each billing period for supplies under this tariff shall be the sum of charges (i) and (ii) given below :-
  - (i) A unit charge at the basic rate of Rs. 6.90 per unit for units consumed within the hours from 10.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m. the following day.
  - (ii) A unit charge at the basic rate of Rs. 15.00 per unit for units consumed in the hours from 7.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m. each day.
  - (iii) A fixed charge of Rs. 30.00 per billing period if the contract demand is 10kVA or below and a fixed charge of Rs. 230.00 if the contract demand is above 10kVA but less than 42kVA.

Rate I-2 (T.D)

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies at each individual point of supply delivered and metered at 400/230 Volts nominal and where the contract demand is equal to or exceeds 42kVA.
- (b) The charges in each billing period for supplies under this tariff shall be the sum of charges (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) given below :-
  - (i) A maximum demand charge at the rate of Rs. 380.00 per kVA of the maximum demand made during a billing period,
  - (ii) A unit charge at the basic rate of Rs. 6.50 per unit for units consumed within the hours from 10.0 p.m. to 7.00 p.m. the following day.
  - (iii) A unit charge at the basic rate of Rs. 14.70 per unit for units consumed in the hours from 7.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m. each day.
  - (iv) A fixed charge of Rs. 800.00 per billing period.

Rate I-3 (T.D)

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies at each individual point of supply delivered and metered at 11,000 Volts nominal and above.
- (b) The charges in each billing period for supplies under this tariff shall be the sum of charges (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) given below :-
  - (i) A maximum demand charge at the rate of Rs. 360.00 per kVA of the maximum demand made during a billing period.
  - (ii) A unit charge at the basic rate of Rs. 6.10 per unit for units consumed within the hours from 10.0 p.m. to 7.00 p.m. the following day.
  - (iii) A unit charge at the basic rate of Rs. 14.00 per unit for units consumed in the hours from 7.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m. each day.
  - (iv) A fixed charge of Rs. 800.00 per billing period.
