EXCISE ORDINANCE

Excise Notification No. 878

BY virtue of the powers deligated to me by Section 4 (2) of the Excise Notification 509 published in *Gazette* No. 13,529 of 22.02.1963, I Parakkrama Ekanayake Bandara, Commissioner General of Excise, do hereby direct under section 25 of the Excise Ordinance (Chapter 52) that the export of liquor on permits issued by me under section 12 of the Excise Ordinance shall be permitted on payment of excise duty or on furnishing a bond or Bank guarantee for export of such article on a duty free basis and such bond or guarantee shall be acceptable to the Commissioner General of Excise.

Exporters of liquor for purpose of this notification shall be deemed to be Excise Licensees and shall be permitted to purchase their liquor for export from manufactures or wholesalers. Exporters shall furnish to the satisfaciion of the Commissioner General of Excise, all documents referred to in the Schedule hereto within 30 days of export of the liquor to be entitled to duty free concession in the case of indirect Exporters only, the time limitation of submitting the relevant documents will be sixty days, falling which excise duty shall be paid by the Exporters at the prevalent rates in addition to any penalties that may be levied.

Excise Notification EN 853 published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1272/34, of 24th January, 2003 be rescinded.
