ACTING under the powers vested in it by Section 12(1) of the Consumer Affairs Authority Act, No. 09 of 2003, the Consumer Affairs Authority directs that no manufacturer or trader shall, manufacture, sell or offer for sale or store for sale any locally manufactured or locally produced Eight Requisites (Ata Pirikara) unless such articles are in conformity with the corresponding Sri Lanka Standards SLS 1257 and SLS 1258 and bear the SLS Mark (Product Certification Mark) issued by the Sri Lanka Standards Institution on each and every item of the Eight Requisites.

This direction shall come into effect from 01st January, 2006.
