STATEMENT OF MATTER IN DISPUTE

The matters in dispute between the aforesaid parties are-

(1) Whether Mr. S. Palliyaguru who had been in the service of the post of Grade 05 at the National Paper Company Limited is entitled to receive an additional increment for assigning him to serve in a post of Grade 05 with more responsibilities by the said Company during the period of 14.02.1997 up to the date of his retirement from service on 12.08.2002 and if not, to what relief he is entitled; and

(2) Whether Mr. S. Palliyaguru is entitled to receive wages for 10,11 and 12th of August 2002 (03 days) on which he was on duty, due to the reason that the Company delayed to hand over the letter of retirement to him and if not to what relief he is entitled.
