## THE FOREST ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 451)

### Notification under Section 30

BY virtue of powers vested in me by Section 30 of the Forest Ordinance (Chapter 451) as amended, I, Abdul Hameed Mohammed Fowzie Minister of Environment and Natural Resources do by this notification.

1. direct each of the areas specified in schedule "A" hereto be an area in which all unmarked or unstamped timber shall be deemed to be the property of the state, unless and until any person establishes his right thereto as provided in Chapter VI of the Forest Ordinance ;
2. exempt, in so far as the areas specified in Column I of Schedule "B" hereto are concerned, the species of timber specified in the corresponding entries in Column II of that schedule, from the provisions of Section 30 of that Ordinance ; and
3. rescind the Notifications made under the said Section 30 and published in *Gazette Extraordinary* no. 1129/13 of 28th April 2000, No. 1175/14 of 15th March 2001, No. 1195/13 of 01st August 2001 and No. 1253/6 of 09th September 2002 and any other notifications made subsequently under the said Section 30 and published in *Gazettes*.
