(1) These regulations may be cited as regulations relating to the payment of allowances to the Mayor, Deputy Mayor and Members of the Municipal Council.

(2) Allowances may be paid to the elected Mayor, Deputy Mayor and Members of the Municipal Council at the following rates per mensem.

Mayor	-	Rs. 15,000
Deputy Mayor	-	Rs. 10,000
Member	-	Rs. 7,000

Entertainment allowance, too, is included in the above.

(3) (1) Due to any one of the following reasons the Mayor, Deputy Mayor or Member of the Municipal Council shall not have the right for the aforesaid allowances.

- (i) Non attending to council meetings and committee meetings held in the month considered for the payment of allowances, or
- (ii) Being kept under detention or imprisoned due to any criminal allegation, or
- (iii) Except for medical reasons being on leave on the approval of the council, or
- (iv) Suspension of functioning of the Municipal Council or of functions of a Mayor, Deputy Mayor or Member under the provisions of Section 277(1B) (a) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance (Chapter 252).

However, on an occasion when the period under detention or being imprisoned or on leave under suspension of service can be counted as a part of a month, payments can be made in proportionate to the rest of the month.

(2) Whatever, the reasons given in sub paragraph (1) of Paragraph 1 of the regulation 3, on an occasion when the Mayor, Deputy Mayor or a Member is attending a duty on formal approval, his allowances should not be suspended due to being absent from a council meeting or committee meeting.
