CEYLON ELECTRICITY BOARD

Tariffs and Charges

NOTICE is hereby given in terms of Section 52(2) of the Ceylon Electricity Board Act, No. 17 of 1969, that it is proposed to introduce the following fixed charges for all direct consumers of the Ceylon Electricity Board and the Tariffs and Charges for the bulk supplies provided to “Lanka Electricity Co. (Pvt.) Limited”. SECTION I

DOMESTIC TARIFF

Rate D-1

The fixed charge per billing period for supply under this tariff will be as follows :

- (i) For those who consume up to 30 units (1st block), a fixed charge of Rs. 60 ;
- (ii) For those who consume in excess of 30 units up to 60 units (2nd block), a fixed charge of Rs. 90 ;
- (iii) For those who consume in excess of 60 units up to 90 units (3rd block), a fixed charge of Rs. 120 ;
- (iv) For those who consume in excess of 90 units up to 180 units (4th block), a fixed charge of Rs. 180 ;
- (v) For those who consume in excess of 180 units (5th block), a fixed charge of Rs. 240.

SECTION 2

TARIFF APPLICABLE TO RELIGIOUS PREMISES AND CHARITABLE INSTITUTIONS

Rate R-1

The fixed charge per billing period for supply under this tariff will be as follows :

- (i) For those who consume up to 30 units (1st block), a fixed charge of Rs. 60 ;
- (ii) For those who consume in excess of 30 units up to 90 units (2nd block), a fixed charge of Rs. 90 ;
- (iii) For those who consume in excess of 90 units up to 180 units (3rd block), a fixed charge of Rs. 180 ;
- (iv) For those who consume in excess of 180 units (4th block), a fixed charge of Rs. 240.

SECTION 3

GENERAL PURPOSE/INDUSTRIAL/HOTEL TARIFF

The fixed charges per billing period applicable for supply under General Purpose, Industrial and Hotel Tariffs will be as follows :

Rate G.P.-1/I-1/I-1 (T.D.)

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies at each individual point of supply delivered and metered at 400/230 Volts nominal and where the contract demand is less than 42KVA ;
- (b) A fixed charge of Rs. 240 if contract demand is 10KVA and below and a fixed charge of Rs. 500 if the contract demand is above 10KVA but less than 42KVA.

Rate G.P.-2/I-2/I-2 (T.D.)

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies at each individual point of supply delivered and metered at 400/230 Volts nominal and where the contract demand is equal to or exceeds 42KVA ;
- (b) A fixed charge of Rs. 3,000 per billing period.

Rate G.P.-3/I-3/I-3 (T.D.)

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies at each individual point of supply delivered and metered at 11,000 Volts nominal and above ;
- (b) A fixed charge of Rs. 3,000 per billing period.

SECTION 4

TARIFF APPLICABLE FOR BULK SALES TO LANKA ELECTRICITY COMPANY (PVT.) LTD.

The rates L.1 and L.2 set out below shall apply to bulk supplies provided to Lanka Electricity Co. (Pvt.) Limited.

Rate L-1.

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies delivered and metered at 400/230 Volts nominal. The charges in each billing period under this tariff shall be the sum of the charges (i) and (ii) given below :-
 - (i) A maximum demand charge at the rate of Rs. 240 per KVA of the maximum demand made during the billing period at each individual point of supply ;
 - (ii) A basic rate of Rs. 7.80 per unit.

Rate L-2.

- (a) This rate shall apply to supplies delivered and metered at 11,000 Volts nominal and above. The charges in each billing period under this tariff shall be sum of the charges (i) and (ii) given below :-

- (i) A maximum demand charge at the rate of Rs. 220 per KVA of the maximum demand made during the billing period at each individual point of supply ;
- (ii) A basic rate of Rs. 5.90 per unit.

1. *Installation Testing :*

First testing of new installation and extensions to installation	Free
Each additional testing, if first testing is unsatisfactory :	
Single phase installation	Rs. 1,000
Three phase installation	Rs. 1,500

2. *Retail Meter Testing :*

Testing meter at consumer's request	Rs. 620
(If the inaccuracy of the meter exceeds plus or minus 2.5%, the fee will be refunded).
