THE WAGES BOARDS ORDINANCE

Glassware Manufacturing Trade

IN Pursuance of the authority conferred on me by the Minister of Labour by an Order made by him under Section 33(1)(a) of the Wages Boards Ordinance (Chapter 136), and published in the *Gazette* No. 58 of 12th October, 1979, I, Mahinda Madihahewa, Commissioner of Labour, hereby notify under Section 28 of the aforesaid Ordinance, that I propose to determine under Section 33(2) of that Ordinance, the minimum rates of wages for time work set out in the Schedule hereto in respect of the workers employed in the Glassware Manufacturing Trade.

Objections to the proposed determination will be received by me until 12.00 noon on 28th March, 2005.

Every such objection must be made in writing and must contain a statement of the grounds upon which such objection is taken.

The minimum rates of wages for time work applicable to the workers in the Glassware Manufacturing Trade specified in Column I shall be the rate set out in the corresponding entry in Column II.

(d) Junior Bubblers, Balancers, Turners	161 00
(e) Glass cutters, Chimney cutters, Grinders	158 00
(f) Packers, Carriers	151 00
