Rubber Export Trade

IT is hereby notified under Section 29(3) of the Wages Boards Ordinance (Chapter 136) that the decisions of the Wages Boards for the Rubber Export Trade made under Section 30 of that Ordinance and specified in the Schedule hereto, have been approved by the Minister of Labour Relations and Foreign Employment.

The decisions shall come into force on the 1st day of April, 2005.

SCHEDULE

The decisions made by the Wages Board for the Rubber Export Trade and set out in the Schedule to the notification published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 9436 of 21st July, 1945 as varied from time to time and last varied by the notification published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 1188/08 of 12th June, 2001 shall be further varied by the substitution for Part II of that schedule of the following new part.

MINIMUM RATE OF WAGES FOR A MONTH

Class of Workers

Grade II

Workers employed in stripping, clipping and bark cutting, Washing and re-smoking mouldy rubber; general labour including moving to presses, weighing machines and other parts of the store; Assembling, wrapping and pricking rubber for bailing, pressing, hooping and wire tying, cutting, jute hessian covers, painting, drying, assembling and marking, treating, jute hessian for special packing, covering bales with jute hessian and stitching, laying out bales, cleaning and sweeping of stores and drains.

Intermediate Grade

Workers employed in weighing, grading and sorting, the work of press operators.

Grade I

Workers employed in loading, unloading and carrying bales, stacking.
