#### MUNICIPAL COUNCILS ORDINANCE

##### Order under Section 325 (2)

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 325(2) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance (Chapter 252), I Janaka Bandara Tennakoon, the Minister of Local Government and Provincial Councils, do hereby make the following order, in respect of transferring assets and liabilities, responsibilities and obligations from the Wattala Pradeshiya Sabha to the Negombo Municipal Council established on April 15, 2002.

#### ORDER

Whereas the administrative limits of Negombo Municipality has been determined by the Minister of Provincial Councils and Local Government by a declaration published in the *Gazette* No. 1218/34 dated 10.01.2002 by the amalgamation of a part of Wattala Pradeshiya Sabha area declared under the provisions of the Pradeshiya Sabhas Act, No. 15 of 1987 with the Negombo Municipality.

and whereas the rights, privileges, assets, liabilities and obligations vested with Wattala Pradeshiya Sabha until the day before the day of amalgamation of Negombo Municipality in exercising and performing the powers, duties and functions by such Pradeshiya Sabha within such part of that Pradeshiya Sabha which was amalgamated to Negombo Municipality shall be transferred to Negombo Municipal Council with effect from 15.04.2002.

Provision has to be made under Section 325(2) of Municipal Councils Ordinance for the transfer of aforesaid rights, assets, liabilities and obligations to the Negombo Municipal Council. Therefore, I do hereby direct that the aforesaid rights, privileges, assets, liabilities and obligations shall be transferred in the following manner.

- (1) I direct that the provisions of Section 325 (1) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance shall apply in transferring the rights, privileges, assets, liabilities and obligations acquired by Wattala Pradeshiya Sabha in performing and exercising the powers, duties and functions of the area which was under the administration of Wattala Pradeshiya Sabha prior to such area being amalgamated to Negombo Municipality.

(2) I also direct that the contribution of Rs. 1311.36 due to be paid to Local Government Service Pension Fund by Wattala Pradeshiya Sabha in respect of the following pensioners shall be a liability of the Negombo Municipal Council.

## URBAN COUNCILS ORDINANCE

### Order under Section 245

### ORDER

Whereas the administrative limits of Maharagama town has been determined by amalgamating Maharagama Pradeshiya Sabha declared under Section 2(1) of Pradeshiya Sabhas Act, No. 15 of 1987 and 16 Grama Niladhari Divisions of Homagama Pradeshiya Sabha and whereas Maharagama Urban Council has been constituted with effect from 15.04.2005.

And whereas no agreement has been reached between Homagama Pradeshiya Sabha and Maharagama Urban Council with regard to the transfer of a sum of Rs. 2,287,408.38 which is the balance amount remaining from the amount paid to Homagama Pradeshiya Sabha by Sri Lanka Telecom Ltd. for renovation of roads in the area amalgamated to Maharagama town and with regard to contribution and gratuity to be paid to Local Government Service Pension Fund by the Homagama Pradeshiya Sabha.

Provision has to be made under Section 245(1) of the Urban Councils Ordinance with regard to the aforesaid assets, liabilities and obligations. Therefore, I do hereby order that the assets, liabilities and obligations relating to aforesaid matter be transferred in the following manner;

- (1) I direct, that the rights, privileges, assets and liabilities vested with the Homagama Pradeshiya Sabha, including the said sixteen Grama Niladhari Divisions amalgamated to it, and its authority of exercising and performing the powers, duties and functions of the said Pradeshiya Sabha as at 14th April, 2002, be transferred to Maharagama Urban Council with effect from 15th April, 2002.
- (2) The balance amount of Rs. 2,287,408.38 lying to the credit of Homagama Pradeshiya Sabha, out of a sum of money paid by Sri Lanka Telecom Ltd. for the renovation of roads shall be a liability of Homagama Pradeshiya Sabha and an

asset of Maharagama Urban Council. The Maharagama Urban Council shall utilize such money for the renovation of roads specified by Sri Lanka Telecom Ltd. If the Urban Council of Maharagama decides not to renovate afore mentioned private roads, it is a liability of Maharagama Urban Council to refund the aforesaid sum of money to Sri Lanka Telecom Ltd. and,

- (3) The pension contributions and pension gratuity due from Homagama Pradeshiya Sabha to the Local Government Service Pension Fund shall be a proportionate liability of the aforesaid Pradeshiya Sabha and Urban Council.

### ORDER

Whereas the Gampaha town declared under Section 2(1) of the Urban Councils Ordinance (Chapter 255) and a part of Gampaha Pradeshiya Sabha declared under Section 2(1) of Pradeshiya Sabhas Act, No. 15 of 1987 have been amalgamated and Gampaha Municipality has been declared under Section 2 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance (Chapter 252) with effect from 15.04.2002 constituting the Gampaha Municipal Council.

and whereas the rights, privileges, assets, liabilities and obligations vested with Gampaha Pradeshiya Sabha until the day before the date of constitution of Gampaha Municipality in exercising and performing the powers, duties and functions by such Pradeshiya Sabha within such part of that Pradeshiya Sabha which was amalgamated to Gampaha Municipal Council shall be transferred to Gampaha Municipal Council with effect from 15.04.2002.

and in order to transfer the aforesaid rights, privileges, assets, liabilities and obligations to the Municipal Council of Gampaha, provision has to be made under Section 325(2) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance. Therefore, I do hereby direct that the aforesaid rights, privileges, liabilities and obligations be transferred in the following manner;

- (1) I direct that the Section 325(1) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance shall apply in transferring the rights, privileges, assets, liabilities and obligations acquired by Gampaha Pradeshiya Sabha in performing and exercising the powers, duties and functions of the area which was under the administration of Gampaha Pradeshiya Sabha prior to such area being amalgamated to Gampaha Municipality, subject to the exception that the assets shown in this schedule vested with the Gampaha Pradeshiya Sabha prior to such area being amalgamated to the Gampaha Municipality, continue to remain with the Gampaha Pradeshiya Sabha.

(2) I direct that the contribution of Rs. 7882.95 due to be paid to Local Government Service Pension Fund by Gampaha Pradeshiya Sabha in respect of the following pensioners be a liability of the Gampaha Municipal Council.
