DEARNNESS ALLOWANCE PAYABLE TO LABOURERS COVERED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE MINIMUM WAGES (INDIAN LABOUR) ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 135) BUT TO WHOM WAGES BOARDS DECISIONS DO NOT APPLY
