ORDER UNDER SECTION 07

BY virtue of the powers vested on me under Section 7 of the Finance Statute No. 17 of 1990 of the Central Province, Provincial Council, I, Sarath Ekanayake, Chief Minister and Minister of Finance and Planning, Law and Order, Local Government, Education, Transport, Tourism Trade and Commerce, Cultural, Environmental, Land, Housing, Constructions, Human Resource Development and Internal and External Investment of the Central Province Provincial Council, do order fix the following rates of Turnover Tax which shall come into effect from the date of 01st January, 2007.

| (d) In respect of the turnover of business buying and selling furniture (including steel furniture) | 05% |
| (e) In respect of the turnover of business of buying and selling jewellery and costume jewellery | 05% |
| (f) In respect of the turnover of business of buying and selling Arrack (including Processed Arrack
and Blends of Arrack), beer, Wine, Toddy and other Varieties of imported or locally
manufactured Liquor | 05% |
| (g) In respect of the turnover of business of buying and selling Cigarettes Purchased from the
manufacture of such cigarettes or from the importer of such Cigarettes | 05% |

(h) In respect of the turnover of business of buying and selling any article or commodity other than any business referred to under items (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f) and (g) above 01%

2. The order made under Section 7 and published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 642/18 of 28.12.1990 and amendments there to the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1467/14 of 17.10.2006 shall cease to apply, upon the coming into effect of this order, in respect of any turnover arising from the date of 1st January, 2007.
