#### FAUNA AND FLORA PROTECTION ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 469)

REGULATIONS made by the Ministry of Environment under Section 71 of the Fauna and Flora Ordinance (Chapter 469).

#### REGULATIONS

The Regulations made under Section 71 of the Fauna and Flora Protection Ordinance, and published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8366 of April, 29, 1938 as amended by *Gazette* No. 59 of May, 11, 1973, and *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1314/16 of November 14, 2003 is hereby further amended as follows :-

(1) by the repeal of regulation 4 thereof and the substitution therefor of the following regulation :-

“4. A charge calculated at the following rate shall be paid in respect of each day of the period of validity of each permit in Form B in the Schedule hereto.

#### CATEGORY I

#### HORTON PLAINS, UDAWALAWE AND RUHUNU (YALA) NATIONAL PARKS

If the applicant is a local adult or local resident	Rs. 30.00
If the applicant is a foreign adult or foreign resident	14.00 U.S. Dollars or its equivalent in Sri Lankan rupees
If the applicant is local child or child resident (Between 6 and 12 years)	Rs. 20.00

If the applicant is a foreign child or not a child resident (Between 6 and 12 years)	7.00 US Dollars or its equivalent in Sri Lankan rupees
For school children (per one child)	Rs. 5.00

CATEGORY II

ALL OTHER NATIONAL PARKS

If the applicant is a local adult or local resident	Rs. 30.00
If the applicant is a foreign adult or foreign resident	8.00 US Dollars or its equivalent in Sri Lankan rupees
If the applicant is a local child or child resident (Between 6 and 12 years)	Rs. 20.00
If the applicant is a foreign child or not a child resident (Between 6 and 12 years)	4.00 US Dollars or its equivalent in Sri Lankan rupees
For school children (per one child)	Rs. 5.00

(2) in regulation 4A by the substitution for the charges specified therein of the following new charges :-

"For each four wheeled motor vehicle	Rs. 200.00
For each car	Rs. 100.00
For each van	Rs. 200.00
For each bus or lorry transporting passengers	Rs. 300.00

(3) by the repeal of regulations 4B thereof and the substitution therefor of the following regulation :-

"4B. (i) The charge payable for reservation at least for five (05) persons to stay in a specified park bungalow shall be as follows for each adult per day. The lodging charge for each child is half rate of the lodging charge for an adult.

Ginihiriya, Gonaviddagala Mahaweli, Wavulebe, Kokmote and Ondaatjee Circuit Bangalows in Horton Plains, Udawalawe Wasgamuwa, Wilpattu and Ruhunu (Yala) National Parks.

Textiles or linen charge	Rs. 25.00

Mahaeliya, Kadurupitiya, Heenwewa, Seenuggala, Thimbirimankada, Thalgasamankada, Veheragolla, Enderuwetamulla Circuit bangalows in Horton Plains, Wasgamuwa, Udawalawe and Ruhunu National Parks.

Park charge	Rs. 60.00
Service charge	Rs. 96.00
Textiles or linen charge	Rs. 25.00

Patanangala, Maseelawa, New Buttuwa and Warahana Circuit Bangalows in Ruhunu National Park

EkgalOya and Angmedille Circuit Bungalows in Galoya and Wasgamuwa National Parks

- (ii) The camp ground charge payable for a maximum of 10 persons including children to stay in a camp ground at a national park shall be Rs. 200.00 per day.
- (iii) The charge payable to stay at “Wana Nivahana” rest and “Common Sleeping Hall” in Horton Plains and Ruhunu National Parks -

For One visitor Rs. 25.00

- (4) by the insertion immediately after regulation 4B of the following new regulations which shall have effect as regulations 4C, 4D and 4E of these regulations :-

“4C. The visitors of a National Park shall pay a service charge at the following rates :-

For one tourist party who visit the National Park during the day time only	Rs. 25.00
For one tourist party staying in all camp ground Wana Niwahana and Common Sleeping Hall	Rs. 480.00

- 4D. (i) For the purpose of these regulations the foreigners who have obtained visas to reside in this country are considered as local visitors.
- (ii) The maximum period for which a circuit Bungalow or rest can be reserved for one party shall be three days.
- (iii) The maximum number of adults who can lodge at a camp ground shall be twelve persons including children, If adults only this number shall be ten.
- 4E. The value added tax calculated in terms of the value added tax Act, No. 14 of 2002, has been included in all the charges specified in regulations 4, 4A, 4B, 4C, and 4D.”.
