TRUSTS ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 87)

Order under Section 114

WHEREAS the Trustees of the “Tokyo Cement Tsunami Relief Trust” namely-

1. Mr. Kurupanawa Gamage Leelananda,
2. Mr. Nagaiah Selvanayagam,
3. Mr. Verrahaththy Markandu Ravinthirakumar,
4. Rev. Sathkunanayagam Sylvester Terrance,
5. Mr. Vairamuththu Chandrakumar, and
6. Mr. Vinasithamby Jeyarajah,

have applied to the Minister of Justice and Judicial Reforms for their incorporation under section 114 of the Trust Ordinance (chapter 87).

Now therefore, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the aforesaid Ordinance, I, Amarasiri Dodangoda, Minister of Justice and Legal Reforms, do by this Order, authorize the incorporation of the said Trustees and direct and declare that-

- (a) the Trustees of the said Trust named above and their successors for the time being duly appointed under the rules of the said Corporation and the Declaration of Trust bearing No. 1712 of March 6, 2006 attested by K. Neelakandan, Notary Public of Colombo and shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession and a common seal under the name and style of the “Tokyo Cement Tsunami Relief Trust”;
- (b) the said Trustees may under the said name and style purchase, receive, hold take on loan or otherwise acquire, sell, exchange, mortgage, pledge, lease or otherwise dispose of movable or immovable property of any description on behalf of the said Trust; and
- (c) the Trustees shall by the said name and style be able and competent in law to sue and be sued, to answer and to be answered to defend and to be defended, in any Court in Sri Lanka or elsewhere in all causes and actions arising in relation to the said Trust.

This Order may be revoked, or from time to time be varied or amended in such manner as appear to me to be necessary.
