**THE PUBLIC SECURITY ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 40)**

REGULATIONS made by the President under Section 5 of the Public Security Ordinance (Chapter 40).

**Regulation**

The Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions and Powers) Regulation, No.1 of 2005 published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1405/14 of August, 13, 2005 and deemed to be in force by virtue of Section 2A of the Public Security Ordinance and amended from time to time, is hereby further amended by the insertion immediately after Regulation 58 of that regulation of the following new regulation :-

“Secretary  
Defence to take  
action where  
death is caused to  
a police officer or  
a member of the  
armed forces.

**58A.** Notwithstanding the preceding provisions of this regulation, where death is caused to a police officer or a member of the armed forces, it shall be lawful for the Secretary to the Ministry of the Minister in charge of the Subject of Defence, to instruct the Inspector - General of Police or the Commander of the Sri Lanka Army, the Commander of the Sri Lanka Navy or the Commander of the Sri Lanka Air Force as the case may be, to take all such measures as may be necessary for the cremation or burial of the dead body, subject to such restrictions and conditions as he may impose in the interest of national security, or for the maintenance or preservation of public order.”.
