THE LAND ACQUISITION ACT (CHAPTER 460)

Declaration under Section 5

I, Chamal Jayantha Rajapaksha, Minister of Agriculture Development hereby declare, under Sub-section (1) of Section 5 of the Land Acquisition Act, that the land described below is needed for a public purpose and will be acquired under the provisions of that Act.

Portions of land called Kallagehena containing in total extent of 0.1445 Hectare, depicted as Lots A, B, C and D in the Advance Tracing No. MR/DVN/2001/349 dated 26.10. 2001, prepared by the Surveyour-General, situated in the village of Thalalla-North Gramaniladhari Division, in the Division of Devinuwara Divisional Secretariat, Matara District in Southern Province and bounded as follows:

Declaration under Section 5
