THE PUBLIC SECURITY ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 40)

REGULATIONS made by the President under section 5 of the Public Security Ordinance (Chapter 40).

Regulation

The Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions and Powers) Regulation, No. 01 of 2005 Published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1405/14 of August 13, 2005 and deemed to be in force by virtue of Section 2A of the Public Security Ordinance, and amended from time to time, is hereby further amended as follows :-

- (1) in regulation 2 of that regulation, by substitution for the definition of the expression “essential service” of the following definition :-

“ ‘essential service’ means any service which is of public utility or is essential for national security or for the preservation of public order or to the life of the community and includes any Department of the Government or branch thereof, which is declared in terms of regulation 40 of these regulations ;” ;

- (2) in regulation 40 of that regulation :-

- (a) in paragraph (1) of that regulation, by the substitution for all the words “Where any service is declared by order made by the President under regulation 2” of the words “The President may by Order published in the *Gazette* declares any service to be an essential service for the purpose of these regulations. Where any service is declared ” ; and

(b) in paragraph (2) of that regulation, by the substitution for all the words “Where the President by Order published in the *Gazette*” to “declared as such” Where the President by Order published in the *Gazette*” declares any service to be an essential service”; and

(3) by the repeal of the Schedule to that regulation.
