By Laws

THE By-law regarding to parking of hiring motor vehicles framed by Panwila Pradeshiya Sabha to Kandy District in the Administrative Area of Central Provincial Council in terms of Section 122 and 126 of the Pradeshiya Sabha Act, No. 15 of 1987 and has approved by the Minister-in-charge of the Subject of Local Government by virtue of the power vested in him by Section 123 of Pradeshiya Sabha Act, No. 15 of 1987 read together with, Section 2 (1) of the Provincial Council Consequential Act, No. 12 of 1989.

THE BY-LAW REGARDING TO PARKING OF HIRING MOTOR VEHICLES

PANWILA PRADESHIYA SABHA

1. These by-laws are framed in terms of the powers vested by Section 122 and 126 (7) of the Pradeshiya Sabha Act, No. 15 of 1987.
2. These by-laws are known as by-laws to control the parking of hiring vehicles within the administrative limits of Panwila Pradeshiya Sabha and will be effective from date of publication in the Gazette of Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.
3. No hiring vehicles shall be parked in any place other than the places denoted in the first schedule and approved by the council and fixed by the Chairman. Such places may be decided by means of a resolution of the council.
4. For parking hiring vehicles in the place reserved in terms of by-laws 3, a fee in terms of schedule two shall be paid yearly to the Pradeshiya Sabha. Such fees should be fixed from time to time, by resolution of the council.

5. No person shall park a hiring vehicle in any place which is reserved as a parking place in the Administrative area of the Pradeshiya Sabha without a permit issued by the Chairman of the Pradeshiya Sabha or any other officer duly authorized by him and it is effective from 6.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m.

6. A permit issued under these by-laws for any year will lapse on last day of the year in which it is issued unless it is earlier cancelled by the Chairman or any other officer who has been authorized by him.

7. An Application form as per 3rd schedule for a permit shall be submitted to the Chairman. Application forms can be obtained from the Office of the Pradeshiya Sabha and all the particulars required by the Chairman shall be included in such applications.

8. The owner or the driver of any hiring vehicles parked at a common parking place shall forward the permit, when called upon to do for inspection by a Police Officer or Traffic Warden or any person duly authorized by the Chairman.

9. Before 31st of March permit to part hiring vehicles shall be obtained at time only one permit when is valid for a year will be issued.

10. Except the motor vehicles that are presently requested with the Council, any other, motor vehicle is to be parked in a common parking place. Application must be made to the council and a permit must be obtained before parking such motor vehicle.

11. No motor vehicle shall be repaired at the hiring car stand and vehicles shall be parked without obstructing the other motor vehicles.

12. No person shall wash or caused to be washed a vehicle parked in any common parking place.

13. No person shall be have while being drunk in a common parking place or in a hiring vehicle parked in a common parking place or behave in a disorderly manner to be a hindrance to others.

14. Any person who contravene any of these by-laws from 1 to 13 if convicted by a competent Court of Jurisdiction is liable to a fine not exceeding Rs. 750 and in the event of continued contravention the Chairman or any other officer duly authorized by him by giving a written notice regarding the continued contravention he is liable to a further fine not exceeding Rs. 250 for each day of further commission or the offence.

15. Any person who is convicted for more than twice for contravention of these by-laws the permit issued to him is liable to be cancelled and no compensation can be claimed by the permit-holder.

16. In these by-laws, council means, Panwila Pradeshiya Sabha, Chairman means, Chairman of Panwila Pradeshiya Sabha, Authorized person means, a person authorized in writing by the Chairman, hiring vehicle means, three wheeler, lorry, van, tractor, truck, car and two wheel tractor.
