THE PUBLIC SECURITY ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 40)

REGULATIONS made by the President under Section 5 of the Public Security Ordinance (Chapter 40).

Regulations

The Emergency (Prevention and Prohibition of Terrorism and Specified Terrorist Activities) Regulations, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1474/5 of December 6, 2006, as amended by regulation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1511/9 of August 21, 2007, and deemed to be in force by virtue of the provisions of Section 2A of the Public Security Ordinance (Chapter 40), are hereby further amended in regulation 20 of those regulations, in the definition of the expression “terrorism”, by the repeal of paragraph (h) thereof and all the words appearing therefrom to the end of that definition and the substitution therefor of the following :-

“(h) is designed to interfere with or disrupt an electronic system,

and which unlawful conduct is aimed at or is committed with the object of threatening or endangering the sovereignty or territorial integrity of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka or that of any other recognized sovereign State, or of compelling the government of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka to do or abstain from doing any act, and includes any other unlawful activity which advocated or propagates such unlawful conduct. ”.
