THOROUGHFARES ORDINANCE

Order under Section 5A

DECLARATION OF “ROAD DEVELOPMENT AREA” UNDER SECTION 8(1) OF THE ROAD DEVELOPMENT
AUTHORITY ACT, No. 73 OF 1981

BY virtue of the powers vested in me under Section 8(1) of the Road Development Authority Act, No. 73 of 1981, I, Jeyaraj Fernandopulle, Minister of Highways and Road Development declare the area covered under the corridor of 40 metres (20 metres on either side of the centre line) of the existing road from Anuradhapura to Padeniya, as the “Road Development Area” and the Road Development Authority (RDA) to proceed with the planning and to regulate the development in the said corridor as per Section 9(1) of the aforesaid Act.

Therefore, it is required to preserve the aforesaid area, free of buildings and any other encumbrances to accommodate the proposed high mobility corridor in future where Anuradhapura-Padeniya Road (A-28), 84.47 km. in length will be a part of the Northern high mobility corridor, as identified in the preliminary studies and proposed Government plans.
