## PART I : SECTION (I) — GENERAL

#### THE AIR FORCE ACT, No. 41 OF 1949

REGULATIONS made by the PRESIDENT under Section 155 of the Air Force Act, (Chapter 359), read with Article 44 (2) of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.

#### REGULATIONS

The Sri Lanka Air Force (Regular and Regular Reserve) Regulations 1951 published in *Gazette*, No. 10,240 of April 27, 1951 as amended from time to time, are hereby further amended as follows.

1. By the Substitution of regulation 39 of the Sri Lanka Air Force (Regular and Regular Reserve) Regulations to read as “Original period of enlistment of an Airman shall be eight years of regular service with a reserve liability of four years”.

2. (a) In form A of the fourth Schedule of the following amendments.

(i) By the substitution of paragraph 1 thereof, the following new paragraph.

You will engage to serve as a member of the Sri Lanka Air Force for a period of eight years of regular service with a reserve liability of four years.

(ii) By the substitution of question No. 13 (a) thereof, the following new question.

13 (a) - For a term of 12 years, of which the first 8 years shall be in the Regular Air Force and the remaining 4 years in the Regular Air Force Reserve.

REGULATION (*Contd.,*)

(b) In form B of the fourth Schedule of the following amendments.

(i) By substitution of question No. 13 (a) thereof, the following new question.

13 (a) - For a term of 12 years, of which the first 8 years shall be in the Regular Air Force and the remaining 4 years in the Regular Air Force Reserve.

(ii) Insert the following question as 13(C).

13 (c) - If, after you have been transferred to the Regular Air Force Reserve, you are called out for service in the Regular Air Force, then to be liable to be transferred to any unit requiring your services.

(iii) By substitution for paragraph 1 of terms of enlistment, the following new paragraph.

You will engage to serve as a member of the Sri Lanka Air Force for a period of eight years of regular service with a reserve liability of four years.
