TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 269)

Order under Section 6 (2) (b) and Section 21 (2) (b)

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 6 (2) (b) and Section 21(2)(b) of the Town and Country Planning Ordinance (Chapter 269), I, Dinesh Chandra Rupasinghe Gunawardena, Minister of Urban Development and Sacred Area Development, do by this order :—

- (a) declare that the area of land specified in the Schedule hereto shall be an Urban Development Area for the purpose of the aforesaid Ordinance and shall be called the “Weligama Agrabodhi Raja Maha Vihara Sacred Area”; and
- (b) direct that an outline scheme shall be prepared for the whole of the area declared to be the Weligama Agrabodhi Raja Maha Vihara Sacred Area.

SCHEDULE

THE AREA OF LAND COMPRISING THE WELIGAMA AGRABODHI RAJA MAHA VIHARAYA SACRED AREA

The areas of land belonging to the Weligama Agrabodhi Rajamaha Viharaya as depicted in Plan MR/WLG/2008/335 dated 10.10.2008 drawn by the Survey-General situated in the village of Weligama, in the Grama Niladhari Division of Walliwala South (No. 386 B), in the Weligam Korale within the Divisional Secretary's Division of Weligama in the Administrative District of Matara, in the Southern Province and bounded as follows :-

North : by Koswaththa, Awarigewaththa and the Municipal Council Road ;

East : by the Municipal Council Road, Pokunu Kumbura and Banasala Koratuwa ;

South : by Pansalagawawaththa and the Municipal Council Road ; and

West : by Malwaththagewaththa and the road which leads to the houses.
