**FILLING OF A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF A MEMBER OF THE ALAIYADIVEMBU PRADESHIYA
SABHA UNDER SECTION 65A(2) OF THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES ELECTIONS ORDINANCE
(CHAPTER 262)**

WHEREAS the office of a member in Alaiyadivembu Pradeshiya Sabha has fallen vacant by reason of not attending meetings of the Council for a period of three months without permission ;

And whereas the Secretary of the Ilankai Tamil Arasu Kachi, the recognized political party to which Navarathnam Anandan, the member belonged, was required by me under Section 65A(2) of the aforesaid Ordinance, to nominate a person eligible under the Ordinance for Election as a member of that Alaiyadivembu Pradeshiya Sabha, who belongs to such party who shall be declared elected as member within a period of thirty (30) days;
