PART I : SECTION (I) — GENERAL

Government Notifications

ESALA FESTIVAL OF MAHIYANGANA - 2009

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by the Transfer of powers (Divisional Secretaries) Act, No. 58 of 1992, and according to the Regulations in terms of the provisions of the Pilgrimages Ordinance (Chapter 362) “published in *Government Gazette* No. 9902 of 10th September, 1948, *Gazette* No. 14778 of 25th March, 1995 and *Gazette* No. 14752 of 09th June, 1967, I, Kelaniya Bandara Abeykoon Mudiyansele Sunil Abeykoon, the Divisional Secretary of Mahiyangana, do hereby inform that the following orders shall be in force with regard to the camp of Mahiyangana Esala Festival 2009.

1. It is announced, the Mahiyangana Esala Festival will be commenced on the 21st August, 2009 and the closure of the event will be followed by the “Diya Kapeema” ceremony on the 05th September, 2009.
2. The Camp area for abode of pilgrims shall be the land demarcated by the 37th Mile post of Mahiyangana - Bibila main road up to the 1/39 culvert in front of Mahiyangana National School, and the land situated between the Mahiyangana - Meegahakiula road leading to the clock tower in front of Mahiyangana Hospital and the New Highway.
3. No person shall cook meals in “Vihara Maluwa”, “Boa Maluwa”, “Dewala Buhumiya” and “Palle Veediya” (the court yards of the Vihara, Bodhi and Devala) or within those premises.
4. On a permit issued by me or by the Officer in charge of the camp, selling of flowers, joss - sticks, candles, camphor, offering items and statues for fulfillment of vows, is allowed in the strip of land opposite the “Stupa” at “Meda Veediya” and in the strip of land situated to the left of the “Makara Thorana”.
5. Within the camp area specified in above Section 2, selling and distribution of all food to pilgrims and selling of other commodities are allowed in the 24 permanent buildings or the Officer in charge of the camp. The area beyond 20 feet, from the drainage system of both sides of Palle Veediya, Meda Mawatha, Dhutugamunu Vishrama Shala Mawatha (Pilgrims’ rest Road) Ammedilla Road, Badulla-Mahiyangana Main Road, Bodhimaluwa Mawatha, and the road in front of the “Sangawasa” (Bikku abode), prescribed as the way of Perahara procession by the “Basnayake Nilame”, is reserved for business purposes.
6. No person shall expose any commodity of description for sale within the camp area in any place not appointed for the purpose as specified in above Section 4 and 5.

7. Parking of private vehicles in the main street is hereby prohibited and no person shall enter any type of vehicle in to the camp area including bicycles and bullock carts without a permit issued by me or by the Officer in charge of the camp'.
8. No person shall enter any motor vehicle in to the camp *via* the road reaching the sacred area by the side of the "Vaahalkada" (vestibule) which faces Mahiyangana - Bibila main road, Mahiyangana-Bibila old road, the main access to the camp area, the road by the side of the clock tower located in front of the hospital, and the road by the side of 1/39 culvert - in front of Mahiyangana National School, unless written permission is obtained.
9. public notice will be made by me on the procedure of leasing the parcels of land for business purposes within the camp area.
10. All the temporary constructions in the leased out commercial lands shall comply with the specifications made by the Department of Health. 01 or 02 sanitary toilets adjacent to each boutique will have to be made available for the use of pilgrims, if ordered. After the removal of the temporary buildings/sheds by the settlers of the leased out lands at the end of the festival, all refuse and garbage including pollythene shall be collected and disposed under the supervision of the Public Health instructors.
11. No person shall construct any building within the camp area unless a license has been obtained in that behalf from me.
12. No person shall, without the previous sanction of the Divisional Secretary, construct any booth or any sort of building or extend any building, so as to encroach on any land used or set apart for use as a street within the camp area or on any land forming the banks of the river within the camp area.

15th REGULATION (PILGRIMAGES ORDINANCE)

- (a) No person shall, without the previous sanction of the Divisional Secretary, construct any booth or any sort of building or extend any building, so as to encroach on any land used or set apart for use as a street within the camp area or on any land forming the banks of the river within the camp area.
- (b) firing of any sort of crackers is strictly prohibited within the camp area.
- (c) No person shall make any collection of money within the camp area on selling tickets, flags, or on any other purpose unless permission is granted by the Divisional Secretary or other authorized officer.

MAHIYANGANA ESALA FESTIVAL - 2009

ACCORDING to the regulations in terms of the provisions of the Pilgrimages Ordinance (Chapter 362), published in *Government Gazette No. 9902* of 10th September, 1948, *Gazette No. 10283* of 17th August, 1951, *Gazette No. 14778* of 25th March, 1955" and *Gazette No. 14752* of 09th June, 1967 and the Transfer of Powers Act, No. 58 of 1992, I, Kelaniya Bandara Abeykoon Mudiyansele Sunil Abeykoon, the Divisional Secretary of Mahiyangana, do hereby notify that the following places are allocated for the purpose of distributing and selling of food items among the pilgrims.

- (a) All the permanent and temporary buildings in between the 37th k.m. and 1/39 culvert opposite the National School, along Mahiyangana - Bibila road.
- (b) Permanent and temporary buildings on both sides of Mahiyangana - Meegahakiula old road, up to the clock tower in front of the hospital.
- (c) Temporary buildings constructed on a permit issued by me, within the allocated ground for abode of pilgrims inside the camp area.

No person shall distribute any sort of food item in any place not appointed for the purpose, except specified in above.
