THE PUBLIC SECURITY ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 40)

REGULATIONS made by the President under Section 5 of the Public Security Ordinance (Chapter 40).

Regulations

The Emergency (Proscription of the Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam) Regulations No. 1 of 2009 published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1583/12 of January 7, 2009 and deemed to be in force by virtue of Section 2A of the Public Security Ordinance (Chapter 40), is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after regulation 7 of those regulations, of the following new regulation:-

“7A. No person shall—

- (a) engage in or be concerned in or connected with, the collection of funds including membership fees,
- (b) make supplies to, sell, donate or purchase from ;
- (c) rent, lease or obtain or procure any movable or immovable property, material or other thing ;
- (d) supply money by way of capital, receive or give any movable or immovable property, material or other thing ;
- (e) engage in or be concerned in or connected with, the purchase or sale of any offensive weapon, explosive or firearm.

on behalf of himself or any person or body of persons (whether incorporated or unincorporated) in contravention of the provisions of these regulations, with, to or for, the Organization styled the “Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam” or any member of such organization.

(2) Any person who acts in contravention of the provisions of paragraph (1) of this regulation shall be guilty of an offence and all property or money which is the subject of such offence shall be forfeited to the State.

(3) In this paragraph—

“offensive weapon” shall have the same meaning as in the Offensive Weapons Act, No. 6 of 1966 ;

“explosive” shall have the same meaning as in the Explosives Ordinance (Chapter 183) ; and

“firearms” shall have the same meaning as in the Firearms Ordinance (Chapter 182).”.
