IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) ACT, No. 1 OF 1969

REGULATIONS made by the President under Section 20 read with Section 4(3) and Section 14 of the Import and Export (Control) Act, No. 1 of 1969 and paragraph (2) of Article 44 of the Constitution.

Regulations

1. These regulations may be cited as the Import and Export (Control) Regulations, No. 1 of 2009.

2. An enterprise which has entered into an agreement under section 17 of the Law, in terms of which the Board of Investment of Sri Lanka has agreed to allow such enterprise to import into, or export out of, Sri Lanka, any goods being agricultural produce, free of import or export restrictions, shall be entitled to import into, or export out of, Sri Lanka, under the authority of a license issued by the Controller, any agricultural produce which may from time to time be licensed under the Import and Export Act, No. 1 of 1969, provided that the import into, or export out of, Sri Lanka, of such agricultural produce is in compliance with the terms and conditions specified in such agreement.

3. An enterprise referred to in regulation 2, shall without the authority of a license issued by the Controller, be entitled to import into, or export out of, Sri Lanka, any other goods not specified in such regulation.

4. For the purposes of this regulation, -

“Board of Investment of Sri Lanka” means the Board of Investment of Sri Lanka, established under the Board of Investment of Sri Lanka Law, No. 4 of 1978;

“enterprise” shall have the same meaning as in the Board of Investment of Sri Lanka Law.

5. The Regulation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1077/9 of April 26, 1999 is hereby rescinded.
