**FOREST ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 451)**

RULES made by the Minister of Environment and Natural Resources under paragraph (1) of Section 20 of the Forest Ordinance (Chapter 451).

**Rules**

1. The Forest Rules, No. 1 of 1979, published in *Gazette Extraordinary*, No. 68/14 dated December 26, 1978 are hereby amended as follows :—

(1) by the repeal of rule 20 thereof and the substitution therefore of the following :-

“20. The Conservator of Forest may, with the sanction of the Minister, determine the rates specified in the Schedule hereto, to be the fees payable in respect of the collection of forest produce and timber.” ; and

(2) by the addition immediately after rule 23 thereof, of the following Schedule :-

11. **Timber Species** :— Fees for all types of timber (except poles and firewood) shall be the stumpage value. “Stumpage” means the price paid for the right to harvest and remove timber species from the forest.

- (i) “Class I Pole” means timber in round form having a girth over 30cm (12 inches) and up to 45cm (18 inches) at 60cm (2 feet) from the butt end.
- (ii) “Class II Pole” means timber in round form having a girth over 10cm (4 inches) and up to 30cm (12 inches) at 60cm (2 feet) from the butt end.
- (iii) “Class III Pole” means timber in round form having a girth below 10cm (4 inches) at 60cm (2 feet) from the butt end.
- (iv) “Fence Post” means a Class I or Class II Pole not exceeding 2.5 meters (8 feet) in length and 45cm (18 inches) in girth at 60cm (2 feet) from the butt end”.
