Financial Statute No. 01 of 2008

REGULATION made by the Chief Minister and Minister of Finance, Local Government, Rehabilitation, Resettlement, Rural Development, Tourism and Environment Eastern Province Provincial Council, under Section 77(1) (a) of the Financial Statute, No. 01 of 2008 read with Section 37 of that statute.

REGULATIONS

On every instrument and document specified in column I of the Schedule hereto at the rates specified in the corresponding entry in Column II of that schedule.

Stamp duty shall be chargeable with effect from 01st January, 2010.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 76(1)

BY virtue of the powers vested in me under Section 76(1) of the Finance Statute, No. 01 of 2008 of the Eastern Province, Provincial Council, I, Sivanesathurai Chanthirakantan, Chief Minister and Minister of Finance, Local Government, Rehabilitation, Resettlement, Rural Development, Tourism and Environment, Eastern Province, Provincial Council do by this order with effect from 1st January, 2010 declare that the adhesive stamps described in this order be used for the payment of Stamp Duty on the instruments and documents referred to in Section 37 (a), (b) and (c) of that Statute.

Adhesive Stamps of the denomination of Rs. 50 (Fifty), Rupees 100 (One Hundred), Rupees 500 (Five Hundred) and Rs. 1,000 (One Thousand) already issued by the Government of Sri Lanka and overprinted with the English Letters E.P.P.C.
