AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE DAYA SARANA DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION

WHEREAS a Foundation called and known as the Preamble. "Daya Sarana Development Foundation" has been established in Sri Lanka for the purpose of effectually carrying out and transacting all objects and matters

5 connected with the said Foundation according to the rules agreed to the members:

AND WHEREAS the said Foundation has heretofore successfully carried out and transacted several objects and matters for which it was established and has applied to

10 be incorporated and it will be for the public advantage to grant the application:

BE it therefore enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Daya Sarana Short title. 15 Development Foundation (Incorporation) Act, No. of 2013.

2. From and after the date of commencement of this Incorporation Act, such and so many persons as now are members of the $\int_{C}^{O} Daya$ Daya Sarana Development Foundation (hereinafter referred Development

Sarana

- $20\,$ to as "the Foundation") or shall hereafter be admitted as $\,^{Foundation.}$ now are members of the Corporation hereby constituted, shall be a body corporate (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation") with perpetual succession under the name and style of the "Daya Sarana Development Foundation",
- 25 and by that name may sue and be sued in all courts, with full power and authority to have and use a common seal and to alter the same at its pleasure.

3. The general objects for which the Corporation is General objects constituted are hereby declared to be:—

objects of the Corporation.

- (a) to promote religious harmony, mutual understanding, spiritual development, goodwill and friendship among the youth in the area through religious, cultural, educational and economic interaction;
- (b) to protect, support and ensure welfare, interests, safety, integrity and status of people in the area and to safeguard their rights and privileges;
- (c) to provide for the physical welfare and personal development of teenagers through youth development centers including gumasiums;
- (d) to provide additional educational support by giving necessary training in various fields which will enhance their personal qualification levels in order to meet the competition and necessary requirements in finding employment;
 - (e) to hold and conduct periodical technical training camps for the youth to develop their skills with the ultimate aim of projecting them towards finding suitable employment;
 - (*f*) to establish carpentry and masonry and any other suitable vocational training school in central towns and the like with a view to educate and train youth for a vocation;
 - (g) to establish motor mechanism training centers (Garages) in the area in order to train the youth in motor vehicle repair trade and arrange periodical lectures conducted by professionals in the trade;
 - (*h*) to liaise with the Foreign Employemtn Bureau under the Central Government to facilitate applications from eligible youth in the area and recommend them for suitable foreign job opportunities;

- (i) to conduct evening and week-end classes to uplift the knowledge and spoken ability of rural youth in the international language (English) which is a necessity in getting employment;
- 5 (*j*) to set-up an Employment Bank which will collect data of youth in the area together with their educational qualifications in order to find suitable employment in keeping with their educational standards, capabilities and experience;
- 10 (k) to encourage, advice, aid and assist youth financially and otherwise to develop their personal skills for self employment and also find markets for products of those self-employed persons;
- (*l*) to undertake feasibility studies in the agricultural, 15 industrual, technical and other allied fields and to promote the general economic and social welfare of the people of the area;

- (m) to aid and assist youth to commence and operate cottage industries for self employment with a view to uplift their living standards;
- (n) to provide agricultural equipment/machinery for youth to develop and facilitate agricultural and industrial project in the area.
- 4. Subject to the provisions of this Act and any other General 25 written law, the Corporation shall have the power including Powers of the the following powers to do, perform and execute all such acts, matters and things whatsoever as are necessary or desirable for the promotion or furtherance of the objects of the Corporation or any one of them:-
- 30 (a) to procure the Corporation to be registered, incorporated or otherwise empowered or represented or to open liaison offices in any country or place outside the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka;

- (b) to receive or collect grant, gifts, donations, subsidies, endowments and subscriptions whether in cash or in material from donors in Sri Lanka or elsewhere;
- (c) to collect necessary funds for the achievement of the objectives from well wishers by way of donations, variety shows, Non-Governmental Organizations and by other means;
 - (*d*) to take responsible, just and legitimate steps to remove obstacles to the attainment of the above objects;
- (e) to purchase, take on lease or exchange, hire or otherwise acquire any movable property and any rights, privileges necessary or expendient for promotion of the objects of the Corporation and to construct, maintain and alter any buildings or erections required for the work of the Corporation;
- (f) to receive, purchase, sell or acquire all forms of properties both movable or immovable, shares in commercial, industrial and banking enterprises and to accept property bequeathed by deed, last will or codicil;
- (g) to collaborate with, assist and receive assistance from other persons and or organizations engaged in similar activities, whether in Sri Lanka or elsewhere;
- 25 (h) to maintain liaison and affiliation with other related organizations and to enter into agreement with persons or organizations in Sri Lanka or elsewhere in pursuance of the vision and objectives of the Corporation;
- 30 (*i*) to enter in to any contract or agreement with any person, government, organization, company or institution whether in Sri Lanka or elsewhere;

- (j) to open and maintain current, saving and deposit accounts with any bank or other similar institutions;
- (k) to borrow moneys for the purpose of the Corporation on such terms and conditions and with or without security as may be determined from time to time;
- (l) to make, repeal, alter or amend Rules and Regulations defining the manner of management of the corporation and all necessary-by-laws or ordinance for the regulations and conduct of its affairs and the various branches of its activities:
- (m) in general to undertake such other lawful things from time to time as are incidental or conductive and shall be deemed necessary for the promotion of the ideas and object of the Corporation;
- 15 (n) to invest the moneys of the Corporation not immediately required for its purposes in or upon such investments, securities or property as may be thought fit subject nevertheless to such conditions as may for the time being be imposed or required 20 by law;
 - (o) to make, draw, accept, discount, negotiate, buy, sell and issue bills of exchange, cheques, promissory notes and other negotiable or transferable instruments or securities;
- (p) to do all such other acts and things as may be 25 necessary incidental or beneficial to fulfill and accomplish the objects of the Corporation.

5. (1) The management of the affairs of the Corporation Management

shall be managed by a Committee of Management consisting of the 30 of number of members not exceeding fifteen. It shall have a the President, Vice President, administrative Secretary, Treasurer Corporation. and such Officers and staff to perform such duties as the Corporation may determine.

(2) The Founder Member Mr. Daya Dharmapala Kilittuwa Gamage, shall be the first President of the Committee of Management. Any casual vacancy occurring in the Committee of Management shall be filled by the Committee

5 itself subject to ratification by the General Body at its very next meeting. The quorum for a Committee of Management shall be one third of the Members of the Committee.

(3) The first Committee of Management of the Corporation shall be the Committee of Management of the 10 Foundation holding office on the day preceding the date of

commencement of this Act.

6. (1) It shall be lawful for the Corporation to make rules Rules of the with regard to the matters listed below for or any of them Corporation. from time to time, at any general meeting of the Corporation

- 15 and by a majority of not less than two-thirds of the members present and voting to make such rules, as are not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act or any other written Law:—
 - (*a*) The election, appointment or nomination of members of the Committee of Management and their powers and duties and terms of office;
 - (b) The powers conduct of duties and functions of various officers, agents and servants of the Corporation;
- (c) The procedure to be observed at the, summoning
 and holding of meeting of the corporation and of the Committee of Management, the time place, notice and agenda of such meetings, the quorum and the general conduct of such meeting;
 - (d) Qualifications and disqualifications for the membership of the Board Management of the Corporation;
 - (e) Administration, Management and custody of the assets of the Corporation and maintenance and auditing of its funds and accounts;

(f) General administration of the Corporation and realization of its objects.

(2) Any such rule when made under subsection one (1) above, may at a like meeting and in like manner be altered, 5 added to, amended or rescinded.

(3) The rules of the Corporation in force on the day immediately preceding the date of commencement of this Act, shall in so far as they are not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act or any other written Law, be deemed 10 to be rules of the Corporation made under this section.

(4) The members of the Corporation shall be subjected to the rules of the Corporation for the time being and such rules when made may at a like meeting be altered, added to, amended or cancelled.

- 15 7. The seal of the Corporation shall not be affixed to Seal of the any instrument, except with the authority of a resolution of Corporation. the Committee of Management and shall be authenticated by the signature of the President and Secretary or some other two members as may be named for that purpose.
- 8. All debts and liabilities of the Foundation on the Debts due by 20 day preceding the date of commencement of this Act shall and payable to the be paid to the Corporation hereby constituted and all debts Foundation. due to and subscriptions and contributions payable to the Foundation on that day shall be paid to the Corporation for 25 the purpose of this Act.

9. (1) The Corporation shall have its own fund and all Fund of the the sums of money granted or donated to the Corporation by any foreign or local public or private authority or individual, and all the sums of money received by the Corporation in 30 the carrying on of its affairs shall be credited to the fund.

(2) The funds of the Corporation which are not immediately necessary, shall be deposited in any Bank or other institution and the proceeds by way of interest on such deposits shall be utilized for the purposes of the Corporation.

(3) The Committee may exercise all the powers of the Corporation to borrow money and to mortgage or charge its undertaking any property or any part thereof as security for any debt liability or obligation of the Corporation or of any

5 third party.

(4) All sums of money required to defray any expenditure incurred by the Corporation in carrying on its affairs or in the exercise and performance of its functions and duties and in furtherance of its objects and purposes shall be paid out of the fund

10 of the fund.

(5) The Bank account or Accounts of the Corporation with any Bank or Banks shall operate and all cheque drawn signed and endorsed by the President or Vice President or Secretary of the Committee of Management and the Treasurer

15 together.

In this preragraph the words "President", "Secretary" and "Treasurer" shall include any acting President, Secretary or Treasurer.

10. (1) The Corporation shall cause proper accounts to Audit and
 20 be kept of its income and expenditure, assets and liabilities Accounts. and all other transactions of the Corporation.

(2) The books of Accounts of the Corporation shall be kept at the registered office and open to inspection by every member of the Corporation.

- (3) The Corporation shall have its accounts audited each audit year by any qualified public auditor or auditors to be nominated at the Annual General Meeting and the auditors of the corporation shall examine the accounts of the corporation and furnish a report on the accounts examined
 whether and the report shall state in
- 30 by them and the report shall state :-
 - (*a*) whether they have or have not obtained all the information and explanations required by them and;

- (b) whether accounts of the Corporation are properly drawn up so as to exhibit a true and fair view of the affairs of the Corporation;
- (c) the accounts will have its legal validity after auditing and approval of the Committee of Management.

In paragraph the word "Qualified Auditor" means-

- (a) an individual who being a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants Sri Lanka, or of any other institute established by law, processes a certificate practice as an Accountant issued by such institute; or
- (b) a firm of Accountants, each of the resident partners of which, being a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka, or of any other institute established by Law processes a certificate to practice as an Accountant issued by such institute.
- 11. Nothing contained in this Act shall prejudice or Protection of 20 affect the rights of the Republic or of any body politic or the rights of corporate, or any of other persons, except such as are the Republic and others. mentioned in this Act, and those claiming by form, or under them.
- 12. In the event of any inconsistency between the Sinhala text 25 Sinhala and Tamil text of this Act, the Sinhala text shall to prevail in case of prevail. inconsistency.
